

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE LIBRARY

1. The UH Manoa Library licenses many online indexes, journals, and books that you can access anywhere on the planet with an internet connection. You must go through the UH Manoa Library proxyserver to be authenticated as a UH Manoa student.
2. You can borrow books for 13 weeks and renew up to five times. If a book is checked out that you need, place a Recall on it at the circulation desk.

4. If you aren't finding the research articles or data that you need and want help, send me an email, srutter@hawaii.edu.

8. To print articles from the computers you must have a Print Card. You can purchase a Print Card from the Business Offices in Hamilton and Sinclair Libraries or from a Print Card machine within the library. The card also works in the photocopiers. It is \$1.00 for the card and \$.07 per copy.
9. Some departments offer an auditorium or pass code for two copiers located in the Science & Technology Wing, 1st floor.

SEARCHING INDEXES FOR ARTICLES

Aquatic Sciences & Fisheries Abstracts, searching five databases of journal, book, and conference papers on marine and other aquatic life.

- Begin with keyword search
- Look at Refine Search options
- Select *descriptors* that describe your topic
- Use the *Search History* link to combine searches
- *Find It* button to link to UH Manoa resources to find full text articles and/or print journals

Biological Abstracts, journals and books in biology, biochemistry, ecology, and medicine

- Go to *General Search* and begin with keyword search in *Topic*
- Use *controlled indexing* and *classification codes* to refine your search in *Advanced Search*
- *Find It* button to link to UH Manoa resources to find full text articles and/or print journals.

JSTOR Journals, back issues of core journals in science, with a strong collection of zoological literature. A good way to get into older literature.

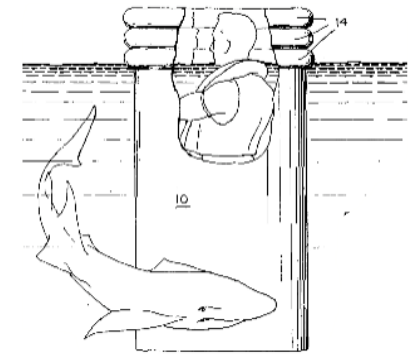
Web of Science, journal articles and some conference proceedings. Allows citation searching and provides citation counts to articles.

- Go to *General Search* and begin with keyword search in *Topic*
- *Find It* button to link to UH Manoa resources to find full text articles and/or print journals.

Zoological Record, journal articles, monographs, proceedings

- Begin in *Advanced Search*
- Use descriptors to refine your search
- *Find It* button to link to full text articles and/or print journals and books.
