Insurance is a Global Business: From the U.S. to the Cayman Islands, Bermuda and Beyond

Natural hazards such as tropical cyclones and earthquakes are extremely rare events and their risk of occurrence not easily assessed through traditional actuarial methods. In the mid-1980's private companies began to develop projection models for cyclone and earthquake risk. He will discuss tropical cyclone risk modeling, including methodology, history, politics and international aspects of this growing global industry.
