Robin Campaniano is a General Partner in the Ulupono Initiative, a Hawai'i-focused social investment firm that strives to improve the quality of life for the people of Hawai'i by investing in companies and organizations that can create large-scale impact to produce more locally grown food, increase renewable energy, and reduce waste. He also serves as a Senior Advisor to Farmers Insurance Hawaii. From 1992 through 2009, he served as Vice Chair, President and Chief Executive Officer of AIG Hawaii Insurance Company and Hawaii Insurance Consultants, and Chair and Chief Executive Officer of 50th State Risk Management Services and American Pacific Insurance Company. Campaniano served as Insurance Commissioner for the State of Hawai'i, and District Director and District Counsel for the U.S. Small Business Administration's Honolulu District Office. He also practiced law in the private and public sectors.

Campaniano received his Bachelor of Arts and Master of Business Administration degrees from the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and earned his law degree from the University of San Francisco.
