SUBJECT: **PROBLEM-BASED LEARNING DEMONSTRATION
AUGUST 14, 2008 & DECEMBER 23, 2008**

The curriculum at the John A. Burns School of Medicine is a tutorial-based, student-centered system called *Problem-Based Learning* (PBL). Because PBL is most easily understood by observation and interaction, anyone interested is invited to attend an orientation session on Thursday, August 14, 2008, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30am and/or Tuesday, December 23, 2008 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 am. The orientation will include an explanation of PBL and a mini-PBL demonstration. For applicants who have not previously attended a mini-PBL demonstration, this will be an opportunity to observe a tutorial group and to interact with faculty and medical students. A tour of the facilities will be provided for those who are interested.

This session is strongly recommended for those applying or planning to apply to JABSOM. Registration will start at 8:00 a.m. at the Medical Education Building of the John A. Burns School of Medicine at Kaka'ako (651 Ilalo Street) in the 3rd floor Auditorium. Parking is available in the parking lot adjacent to the Research Building (enter from Ilalo Street and Forrest Avenue). The charge for parking is \$3.
