*Two electives are ordinarily required, but this depends on the following:

1. The total credits transferred into the MSW Program (See Graduate Division Policy: <http://www.hawaii.edu/graduate/policies/html/transfer.htm>)
2. The previous grades earned in any prior courses being considered for transfer
3. Whether the student is considering the Extended Practicum Option of the MSW Program
4. Whether the student opts for Research Plan A (Thesis Option) or Research Plan B (which can involve a second or third research course)
5. Consultation with one's academic advisor after the student is admitted into the DE MSW Option
