<p><b><u>Spring</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Global and Multicultural Perspectives class, such as HIST 152</li> <li>Biological Sciences course (DB) (select from School of Social Work list)</li> <li>Diversification class – Arts (DA), Humanities (DH), or Literature (DL)</li> <li>Any introductory POLS class</li> <li>Hawaiian or Second Language class, 102 level (3 or 4 credits)</li> </ol>	15 - 16
<p><b><u>Second year – Fall</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hawaiian or Second Language class, 201 level (3 or 4 credits) OR pre-approved culture class</li> <li>SW 200</li> <li>Physical Science class (DP)</li> <li>Biological OR Physical Science class lab (DY) (1 credit)</li> <li>Upper Division elective<sup>2</sup></li> </ol> <p><b>NOTE:</b> You may now apply to the BSW program at the October 1 or February 1 deadline.</p>	13 - 14
<p><b><u>Spring</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hawaiian or Second Language class, 202 level (3 or 4 credits) OR pre-approved culture class</li> <li>PHIL 110 or 111</li> <li>Upper Division elective<sup>2</sup></li> <li>Upper Division elective<sup>2</sup></li> <li>Required class OR Elective of your choice</li> </ol>	15 - 16
<p><b><u>Summer</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Upper Division elective<sup>2</sup></li> <li>Upper Division elective<sup>2</sup></li> </ol>	6
