MSW FINANCIAL AID AWARDS**

1. GRADUATE DIVISION MANOA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE	The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to graduate students who are in good academic standing.
ELIGIBILITY	Applicants must be full-time (min. 8 graduate credits) students who have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better. Full-time = 8 or more credits per semester. Must be Manoa based students. DE and Outreach College students are not eligible for this scholarship.
AWARD	The School of Social Work receives a limited number of scholarships from the Graduate Division annually. They are normally awarded for one academic year, contingent upon continued eligibility. The specific amount and number of awards are determined by the amount of funds available for the year.
REQUIREMENTS	Submission of the standard financial aid application form.

2. OSCAR & GAILE M. KURREN SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE	This scholarship honors the memory of Oscar and Gaile M. Kurren by the awarding of financial assistance to students intending to become social workers in the health care system.
ELIGIBILITY	Applicants must be full-time graduate students in their Concentration year of study, who have chosen Health as their concentration. Cumulative GPA must be a 3.0 or better. Full-time = 8 or more credits per semester.
AWARD	Typically, scholarships of \$500 are awarded on an annual basis, contingent upon continued eligibility. The specific amount and number of awards are determined by the amount of funds available for the year.
REQUIREMENTS	Submit the financial aid application form & a one-page narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award.

3. BETTY LYLE ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP

- PURPOSE** This scholarship was established as a lasting tribute to Betty Lyle Anderson, resolute humanist, social group worker, and faculty member at the UHM School of Social Work from 1949-1951. It is used for the development of persons having professional career interests in **social group work** and **community organization practice**.
- ELIGIBILITY** Applicants must be **full-time** MSW students in their Concentration year of study, who have demonstrated interest in the practice of **social group work** and/or **community organization**. **Cumulative GPA must be a 3.0 or better. Full-time = 8 or more credits per semester.**
- AWARD** Typically, scholarships of \$1,000 are awarded on an annual basis, contingent upon continued eligibility. The specific amount and number of awards is determined by the amount of funds available for the year.
- REQUIREMENTS** Submit the financial aid application form & a one-page narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award.

4. HOA HANA SCHOLARSHIP

- PURPOSE** This scholarship is established to provide funds to students from neighbor islands to complete their education at UH Manoa School of Social Work.
- ELIGIBILITY** Students must be **full-time or part-time**, degree candidates in the UH Manoa School of Social Work. Preference will be given to those candidates who reside on a neighbor island and have expressed, in writing, an intention to practice in the field of social work on a neighbor island, once they have graduated. **Cumulative GPA must be a 3.0 or better. Full-time = 8 or more credits per semester.**
- AWARD** Awards will generally range from \$750 to \$1,500 per school year, contingent upon continued eligibility and status. The number and amount of awards will be determined based on the amount of funds available.
- REQUIREMENTS** In addition to the financial aid application form, applicants must submit a short narrative which addresses the manner in which they meet the eligibility requirements for the award.
- Proof of residency on a neighbor island (defined as, Hawai'i, Kaua'i, Lana'i, Maui, and Moloka'i).

5. **SALLY KANEHE LAMPSON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

- PURPOSE** The purpose of this fund is to provide merit-based scholarships to assist graduate students at the UH Manoa School of Social Work. The scholarship was established in recognition of the pervasive social problems which result from colonialism and culturally repressive forces in Hawai'i and the Pacific region. It is hoped that research supported by this fund will encourage the exploration of effective and culturally sensitive social services to address these problems. Community building projects by MSW students are also encouraged.
- ELIGIBILITY** Recipients must be enrolled either **full-time or part-time** in the masters or doctorate programs at the UH Manoa School of Social Work. Preference shall be given to doctoral students. Recipients must demonstrate leadership capabilities and be planning to pursue regional research in Hawai'i and the Pacific Basin. Some degree of financial need should be shown, but not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines. **Cumulative GPA must be 3.5 or better.**
- AWARD** One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded per school year, contingent upon continued eligibility. The number and amount of awards will be determined based on the amount of funds available.
- REQUIREMENTS** Submit the financial aid application form & a one-page narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award.

6. **ALUMNI & FRIENDS OF THE SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

- PURPOSE** The purpose of this fund is to assist students enrolled in the MSW Program at the UH Manoa School of Social Work.
- ELIGIBILITY** Recipients must be enrolled either **full-time or part-time** in the MSW program at the UH Manoa School of Social Work. Candidates should demonstrate Interest and intent on sustaining and ensuring the well-being of the profession of social work in Hawai'i, the Pacific and/or Asia. Some degree of financial need should be shown, but not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines. **Cumulative GPA must be 3.5 or better.**
- AWARD** The number and amount of awards will be determined based on the amount of funds available. Tentative range: \$500 - \$1,000 per school year, contingent upon continued eligibility.
- REQUIREMENTS** Submit the financial aid application form & a one-page narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award.

7. **HO`OLA`IA O NA KUPUNA `IHI SCHOLARSHIP (Preserving the Elders)**

- PURPOSE** The purpose of this fund is to assist qualified students in the Gerontology concentration of the MSW Program at the UH Manoa School of Social Work.
- ELIGIBILITY** Recipients must be enrolled **full-time or part-time** as MSW students at the UH Manoa School of Social Work. Candidates must be a declared Gerontology student, had taken or will register for SW 726: Practice w/ the Aged, and/or who will be registering for a 2nd year practicum in Gerontology. Some degree of financial need should be shown, but not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines. **Cumulative GPA must be 3.0 or better.**
- AWARD** Two awards will be determined based on the amount of funds available. Tentative range: \$500 - \$1,500 per school year, contingent upon continued eligibility.
- REQUIREMENTS** Submit the financial aid application form & a written narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award. Must show a strong motivation and interest in the gerontology field.

8. **MYRON B. THOMPSON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

- PURPOSE** The purpose of this fund is to support students pursuing a graduate degree at the University of Hawaii at Manoa Myron B. Thompson School of Social Work. Preference will be given to students committed to continuing Myron "Pinky" Thompson's legacy of concern for the health and well-being of Native Hawaiian communities. Funds shall be used for costs associated with attendance (i.e., tuition, books, fees, etc.)
- ELIGIBILITY** Recipients must be enrolled **full-time or part-time** as graduate students at the Myron B. Thompson School of Social Work. Financial need should be shown, but not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to continuing Mr. Thompson's legacy of concern for the health and well-being of Native Hawaiian communities.
- AWARD** Awards will be determined based on the amount of funds available. Tentative range: \$500 - \$1,500 per school year, contingent upon continued eligibility.
- REQUIREMENTS** Submit the financial aid application form & a written narrative that addresses eligibility requirements for this award.
