PARKING GUIDELINES

ZONE 7 (KCHS PARKING LOT) & ZONE 22 (PARKING STRUCTURE):

Zone 7 is a reserved parking lot for Kamakakūokalani faculty and staff and is covered by the University of Hawai'i Parking & Transportation Services. The parking lot opens at 6:30 a.m. and closes at 11:00 p.m. Monday-Saturday. It is closed on Sunday.

To park in Zone 7, a permit is required. There is no visitor's parking from 6:30 a.m. -4 p.m. Monday-Friday. However, a visitor can park in the Zone 22 Parking Structure for a parking fee of \$5 prior to 4 p.m.

Visitor's parking is allowed in Zone 7 from 4 p.m. – closing. A parking fee of \$6 is required. The parking ticket can be purchased from the Gate Attendant at the Zone 22 Parking Structure and placed on the dashboard. If Zone 7 is full, visitors can park in Zone 22.

On Saturday, a visitor can park in Zone 7, but needs to purchase a parking ticket for \$6. This can be purchased from the gate attendant at the parking structure. The ticket needs to be placed on the dashboard.

Persons with a valid Department of Transportation Accessible Parking Placard (Handicap Parking) must pay for parking on UHM campus if they do not have a valid UHM parking permit or pass. As long as they display both the daily ticket and the placard, they may park in the accessible stalls close to the building they are visiting. If all of the accessible parking stalls are full, they may also park in regular stalls, except reserved stalls, with that daily ticket and their placard.

Students who have purchased Zone 22 permits may utilize the parking area 24/7. Students/visitors without a Zone 22 permit may purchase a ticket to park in Zone 22 from 6:30 a.m. -8:30 p.m., Monday-Saturday.

Vehicles in violation are subject to citations and fees. Also, they may be towed to a UH Impound Lot.
