The University of Hawai'i at Mānoa is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for students, faculty, staff, and visitors. UH Mānoa engages in a broad array of activities supporting this goal, including disaster and emergency preparedness planning, as well as a host of other activities aimed at preventing problems before they occur.

Emergency communications is an important component of these activities and is provided in several forms:

Safety advisories and campus announcements:

- All current UH Mānoa students, faculty and staff will receive notices of security and safety-related incidents or conditions through their campus e-mail

In case of an immediate threat to safety, communications strategies include:

- Email alerts
