Help Us Stop Bike Theft

To minimize the chance of your bike being stolen, we recommend that you take the following precautions:

1. ALWAYS lock your bike if it will be left unattended, even for a few minutes.
2. Secure the bike frame to a bicycle rack or fixed object, in a well-lit and designated area.

3. Use a good quality lock. A U-Type lock with a flat key is recommended.
4. The use of 2 different types of quality locks is preferred.
5. Always remove or secure your bike wheels, seat and accessories.
