Articulation Websites

Hae and Joe demonstrated the UH System Course Information System (<http://web20.its.hawaii.edu/articulation/>). It provides information on course equivalency from a sending campus to a receiving one (list mode) and what a course transfers to all other UH campuses (explore mode). The website is relatively easy to maintain as it draws its data from the articulation databases of each campus. ITS will maintain the website. Each campus has been asked to review their own articulation database for accuracy. This website is expected to be made available to the public in March 2006. Feedback is welcomed from all to Hae and Joe. Hae to bring the website to the systemwide meeting of the advisors/counselors in February 2006 for further feedback. It was suggested that an assessment be built into the system so that feedback from students is obtained.
