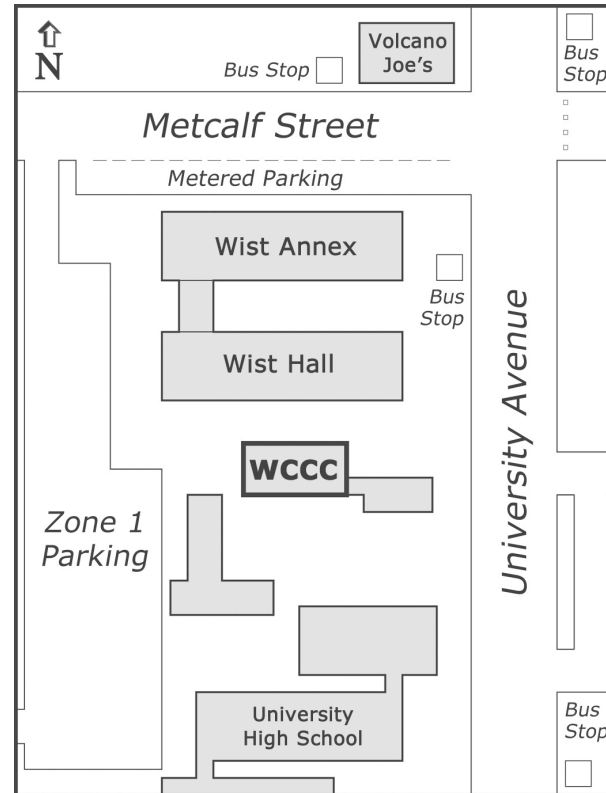

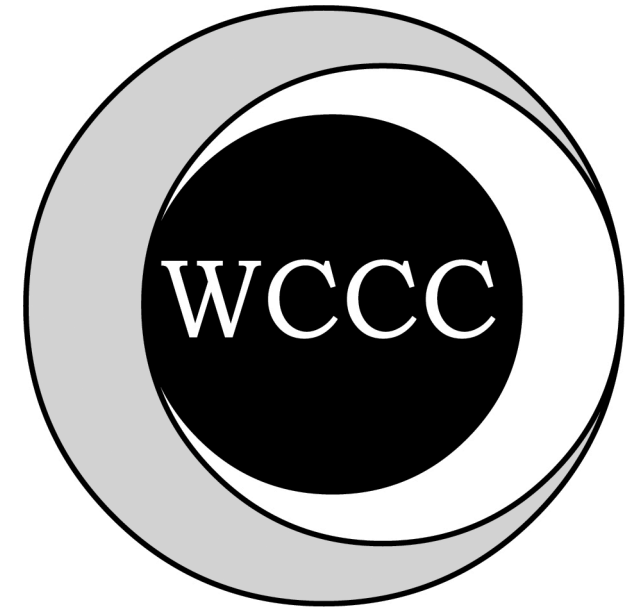

WCCC is a self-supporting Resource Center located at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. It serves as a clearinghouse for over 20,000 curriculum and resource materials, including print, audio-visual, and computer assisted training materials. These materials in career education, school-to-work, vocational, technical, bilingual, drug and violence prevention, and related academic education have been collected from sources throughout the United States and affiliated Pacific Island entities, and for the most part, are not available from commercial publishers.

WCCC's functions include:

- Collection and dissemination of information on curriculum development and resources and other materials;
  - Curriculum needs assessment;
  - Curriculum development activities;
  - Response to requests for materials;
  - Loan of curriculum materials;
  - Database searching;
  - Dissemination of monthly curriculum acquisitions and abstract lists;
  - Development of specialized bibliographies;
  - Provision of technical assistance;
  - Coordination of workshops and training;
  - Linkage to other educational resources through WCCC's homepage on the Web.
