HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION VERIFICATION

Your FAFSA was selected for a review process called verification. In the process, information from your FAFSA will be compared to this document. The law states that the campus must ask for this information before awarding financial aid. B. HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION STATUS

You MUST submit documentation of high school completion status at the beginning of the academic year.

- Official high school transcript or high school diploma including graduation date.
General Education Development (GED) Certificate, official GED transcript that indicates the date the exam was passed, or a state-authorized high school equivalent certificate.
Successfully completed the Ability-to-Benefit test prior to July 1, 2012.
Academic transcript of a successfully completed two-year program acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
If you are a homeschooled student, a transcript or equivalent, signed by parent or guardian, listing secondary school courses you have completed and documentation that you have successfully completed secondary school education.
Students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.
If you did NOT graduate from a U.S. high school or equivalent, received a GED certificate or complete a secondary education home school credential; and was NOT enrolled in an eligible program prior to July 1, 2012.
