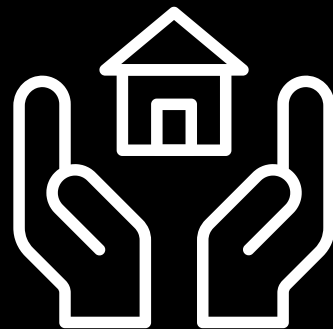


Homelessness and Substance Use in Hawai'i

The homelessness rate in
Hawai'i as of July 2020 was

45.5 per 100,000



The homelessness rate in the
United States as of 2019 was

17.3 per 100,000

Groups at higher risk of
becoming homeless:

- Children of Military Families
- College/University Students
- LGBTQ+
- Micronesian or COFA youth
- Native Hawaiians

An estimated **36%** of
those homeless surveyed
in 2017 reported having
mental health issues and
31% reported
substance use issues

An estimated **88.1%** of
homeless youth in Hawai'i
surveyed in 2018 had used
substances in the past 30 days

Of these youth, **32.5%**
reported being admitted to a
drug treatment program
