- 2. Responsible for transporting patients to scheduled recovery outings.
- 3. Facilitate and monitor patients' leisure time
- 4. Conduct monthly disaster drills and document the results.
- 5. Report regularly to the Residential Program Manager
- 6. Participates in instructing, and monitoring of recovery planned activities, i.e. AA/NA meetings, recreational outings, skill building activities.
