HOW DOES IT WORK?

Challenges process will be conducted through a web portal

1. UH publishes locations to challenge (starts the process)
2. 30-day window to submit challenges
3. Internet Service Provider has the opportunity to rebut the challenge within 30-days of submission
4. If the ISP disputes the challenge, UH will have 30-days to make a final determination (sustain or reject)

90-days in total (tentatively)



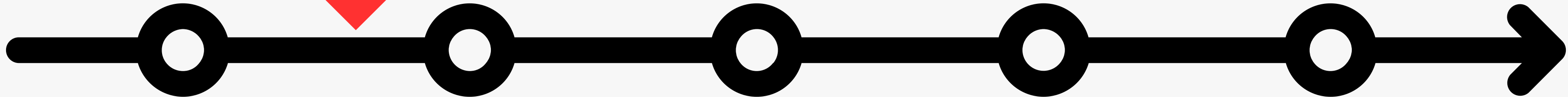
THEN WHAT?

After the Challenge Process is complete, UH will submit the results for NTIA to review. Upon approval, UH can begin the subgrantee selection process for BEAD broadband infrastructure deployment.

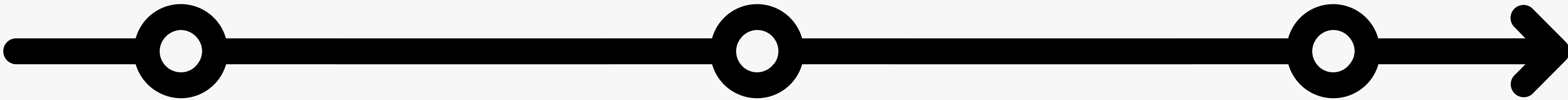
Final Proposal is due in 2024.

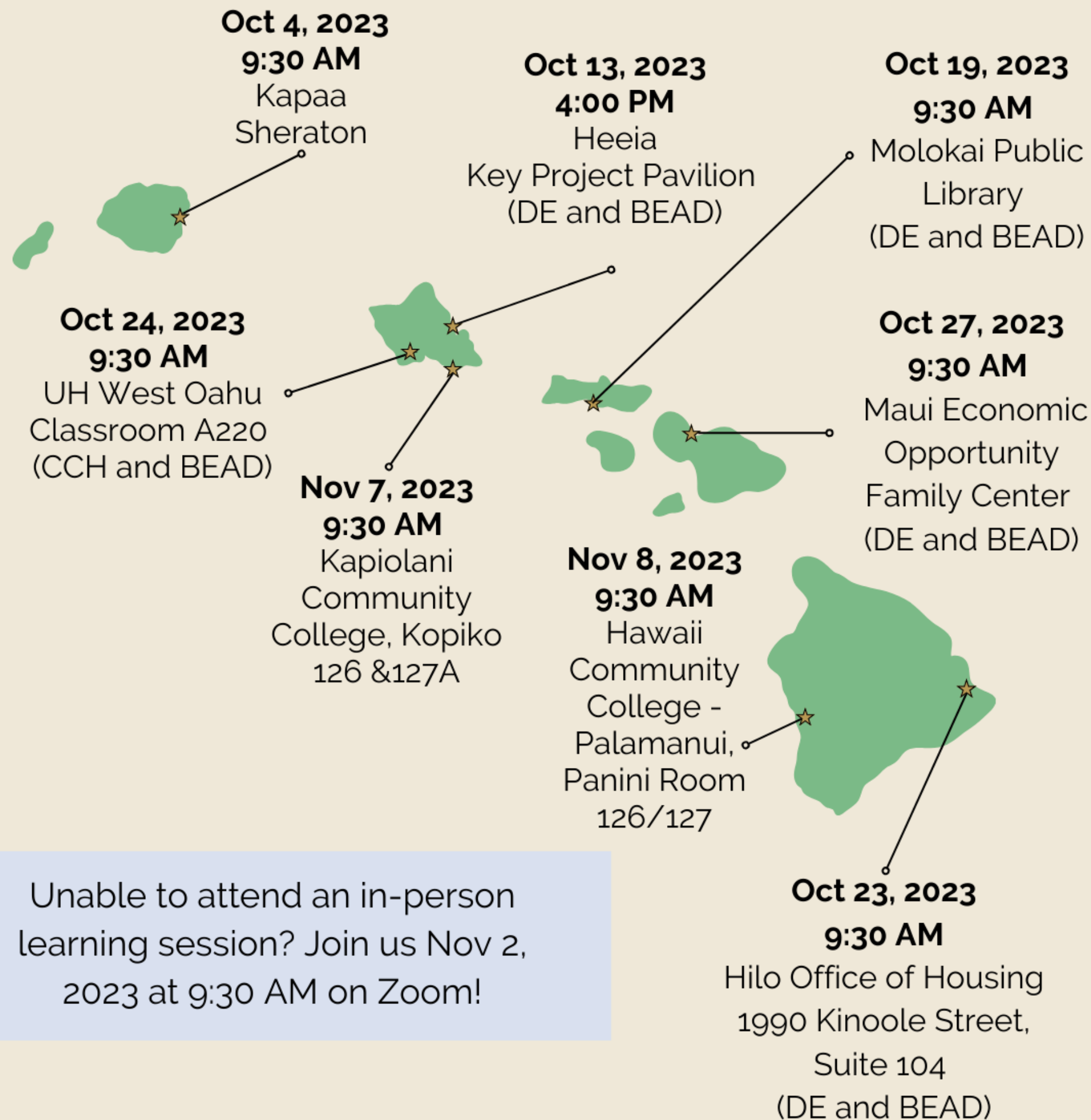

WHAT IS THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD?

The public comment period is a chance for the public to provide input on the Initial Proposal. This is the time to provide feedback on things like the definition of CAIs, the challenge process, and other sections of the Initial Proposal. A public comment period for Volume 1 and Volume 2 of the Initial Proposal is required by NTIA under BEAD.

HOW WILL PUBLIC COMMENT WORK?

UH will share electronic copies of V1 and V2 on the UH Broadband website and will have printed copies available at in-person events. Comments will be accepted in person at outreach events and virtually (via webform and virtual hearing sessions). Formal public comment window is **30 days**, but UH will continuously accept inputs and feedback throughout.
