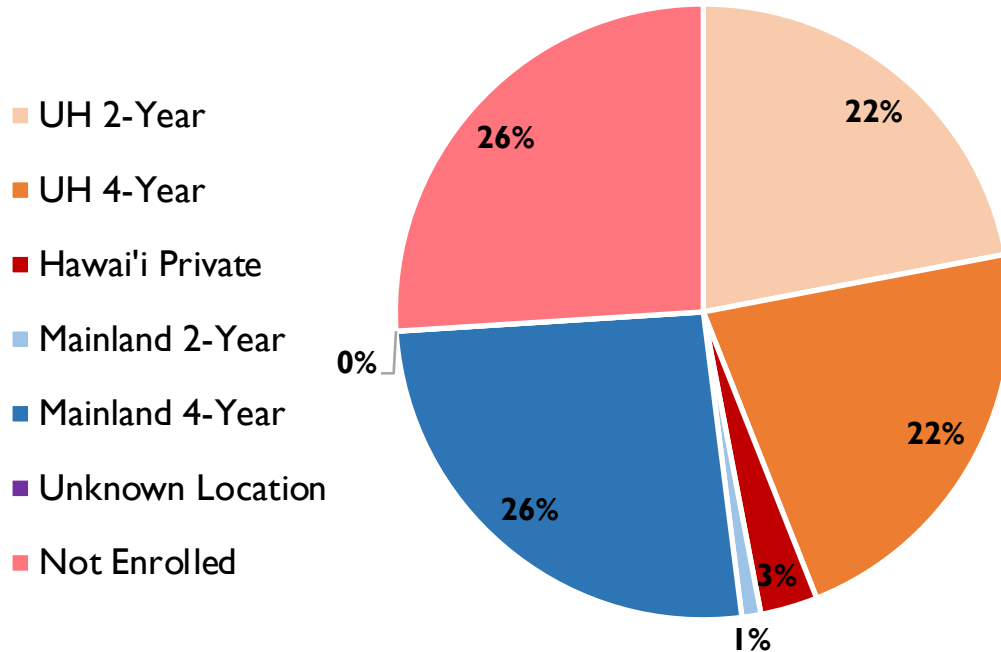
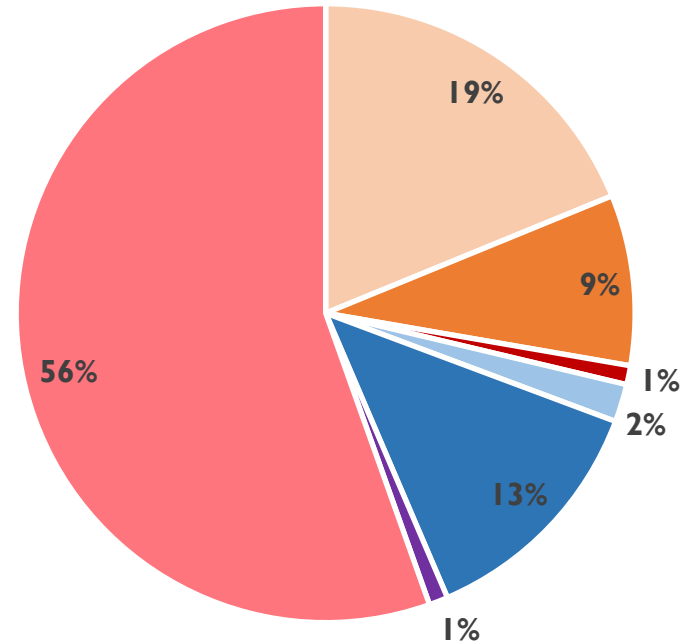

Enrollment Locations for Dual Credit Students



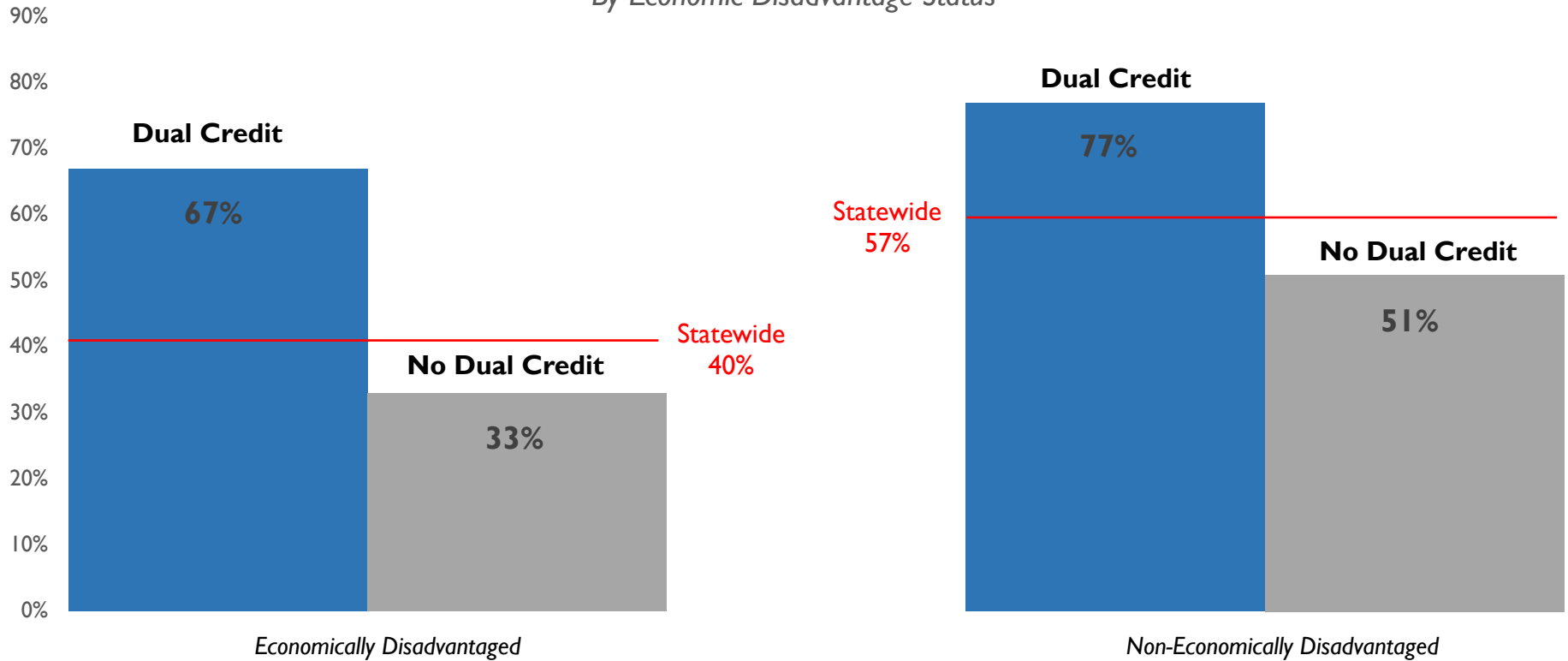
Enrollment Locations for Non-Dual Credit Students

First Fall College Enrollment Rates for Class of 2021

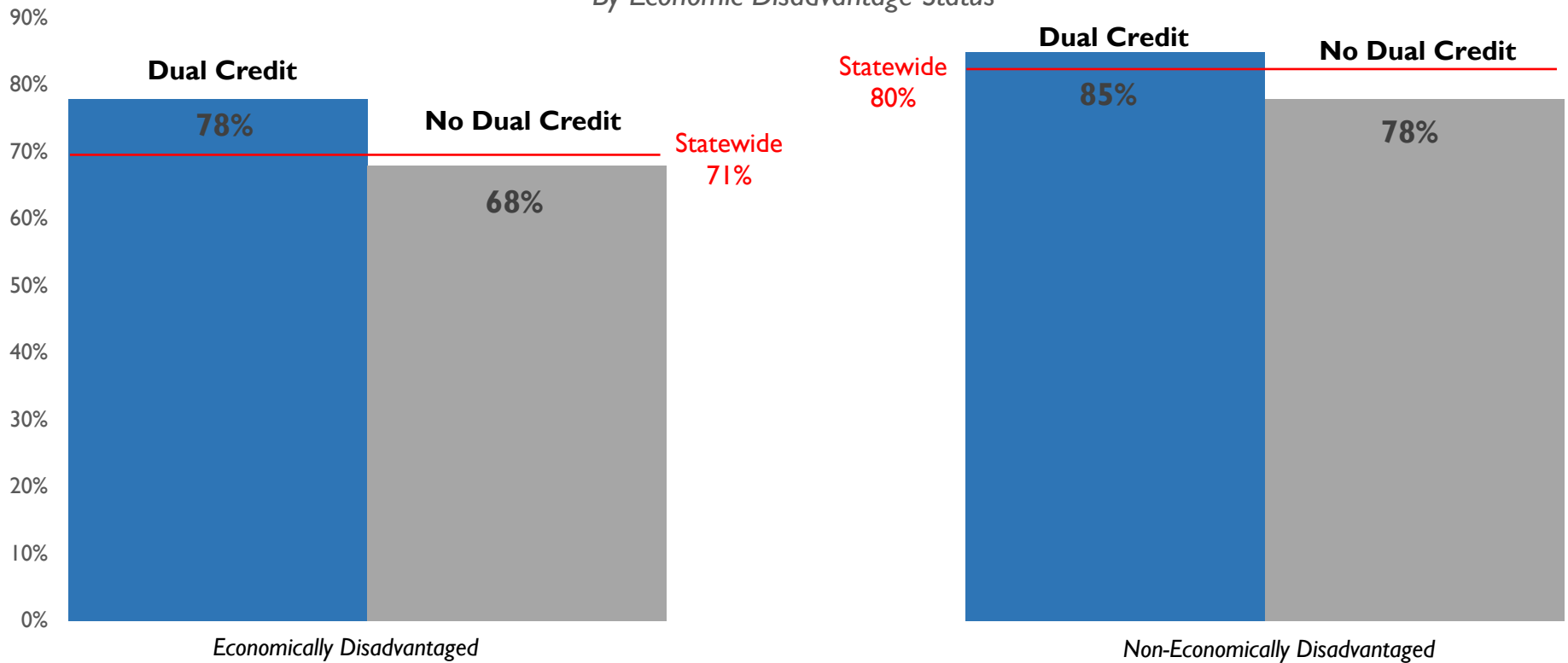
By Economic Disadvantage Status



Economically Disadvantaged Graduates with Dual Credit Persist in College at Higher Rates

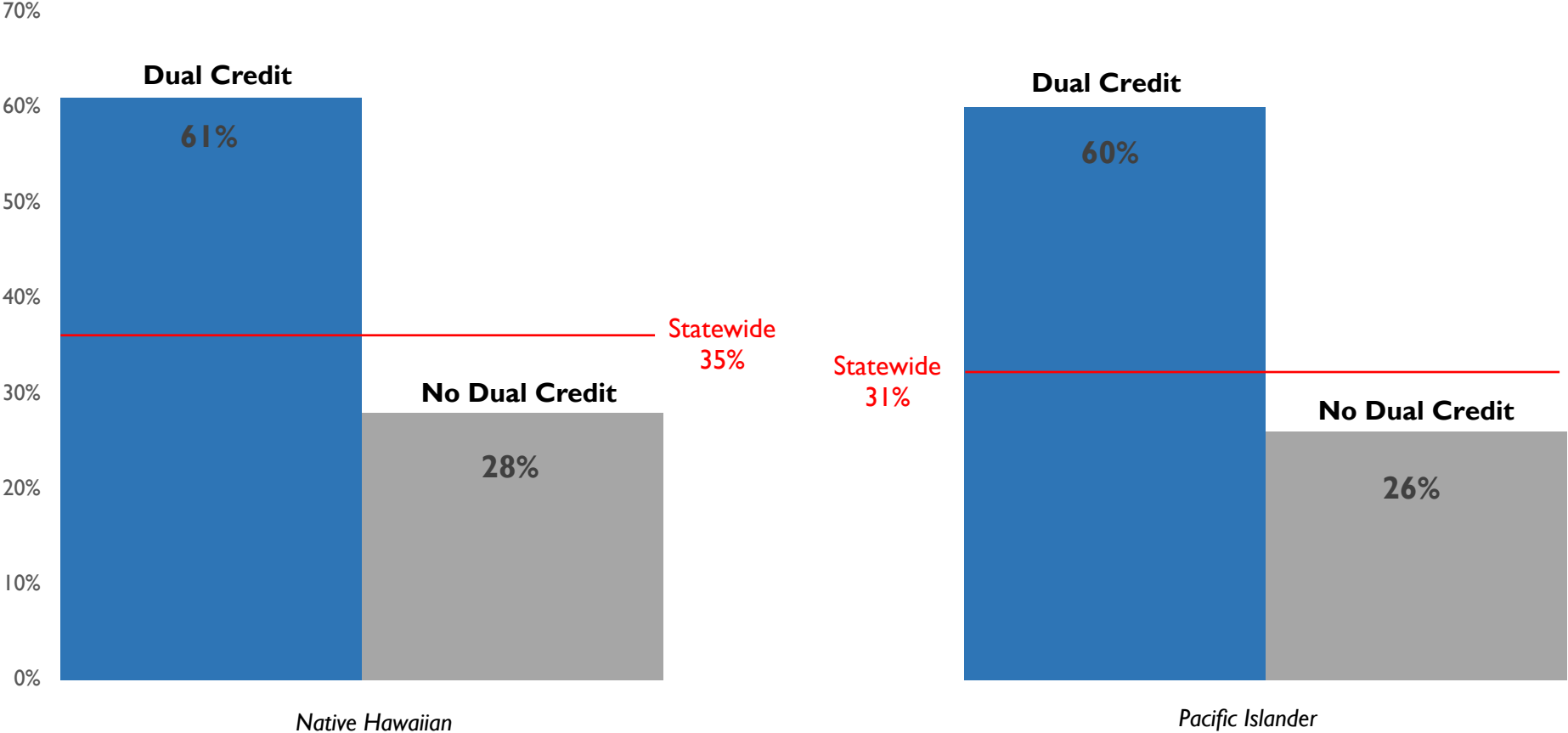
First to Second Year College Persistence Rates for Class of 2020

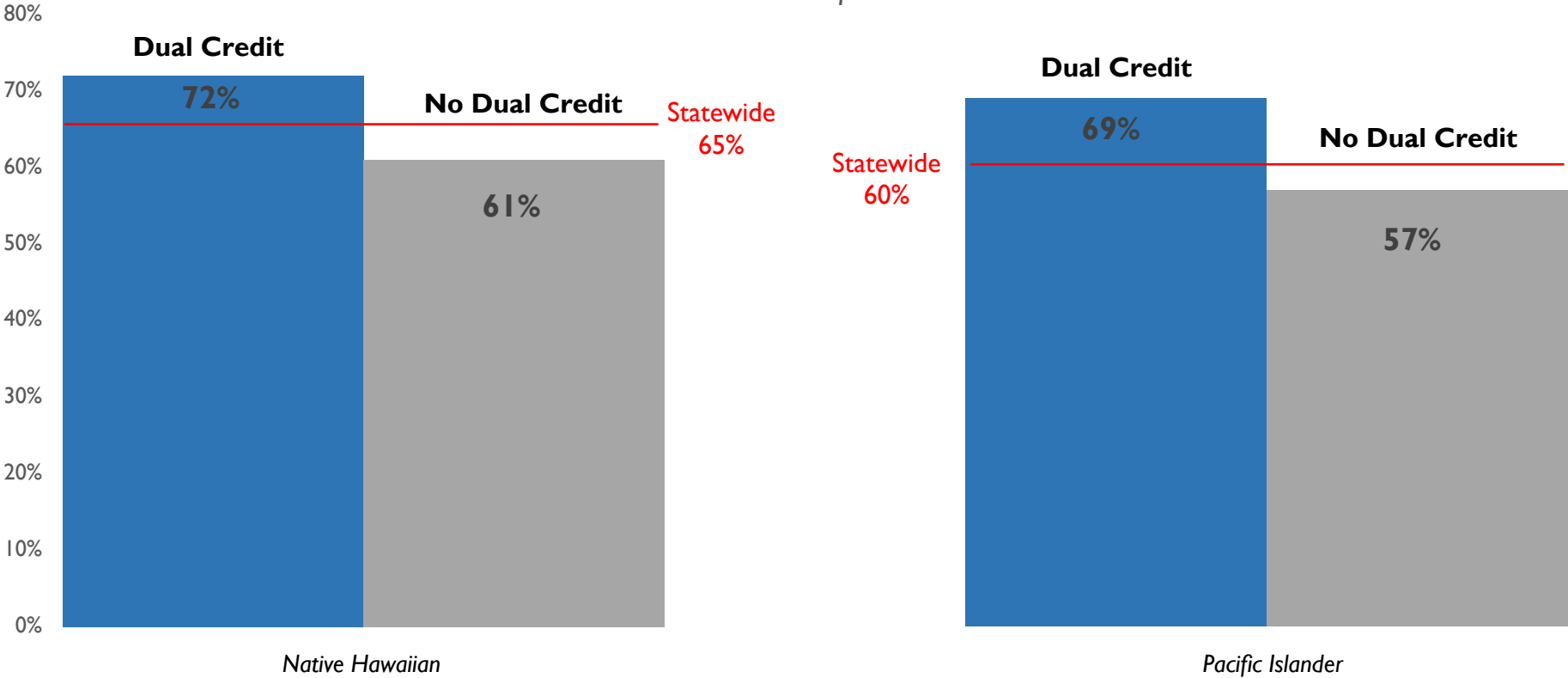

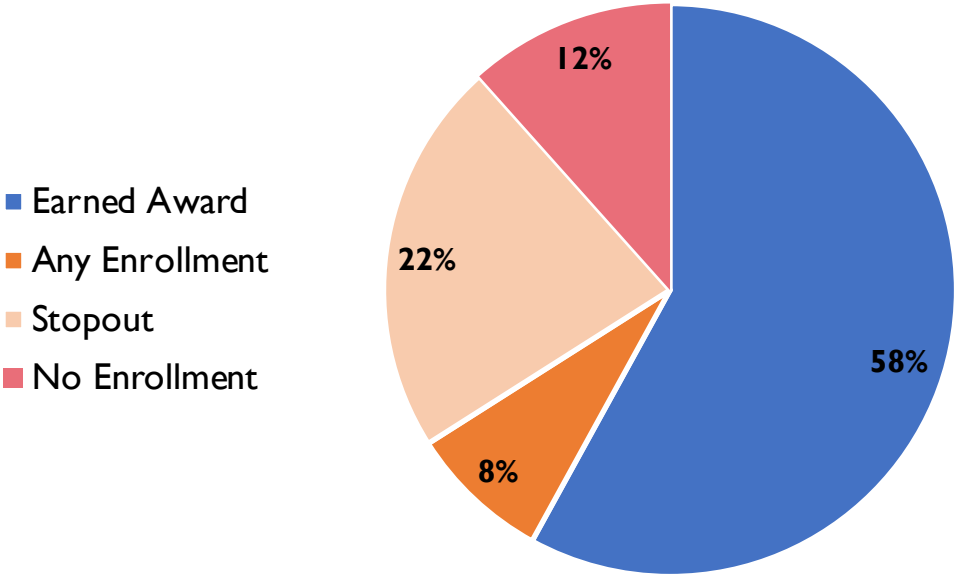
