

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATE IN JAPANESE

The certificate in Japanese is for those students who wish to have credentials in Japanese language skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing) to supplement other fields of study. Students must take five courses for a total of fifteen credit hours from the approved course list. See the certificate requirements below for more information.

NOTES:

- 1) At least two of the five courses taken must be at the 400-level.
- 2) All five courses must be taken for a letter grade, and must be passed with a grade of "C" or better. In addition, the GPA for the five courses together must be 2.5 or higher. Only grades for courses taken at UH-Manoa will apply towards this GPA.
- 3) All courses must be taken within the University of Hawaii system (with at least three taken at UH-Manoa), or else through a study abroad or exchange program which is directly administered by an official UH-Manoa organ (e.g., the Study Abroad Center, the Center for Japanese Studies, etc.) and which is officially recognized by the Japanese Section of UH-Manoa's Department of East Asian Languages and Literatures.
