RE: NOTICE OF RENT INCREASE

Dear residents,

I hope this letter finds you well. As you may know, University Housing is a self-supporting program that has historically provided University of Hawai'i personnel with rental housing priced below current market rates. Since 2019, we have only had one rental rate increase, despite significant increases in the goods and services required to maintain the properties. Rental rates in the private market increased drastically during this same period.

After careful consideration—and in line with current market conditions and inflationary factors—we have found it necessary to implement a rent increase for all three University Housing properties. This three percent increase will take effect on July 1, 2025. The new monthly rental rates can be found attached to this letter.

Additionally, I would like to take the time to highlight some recent repair and maintenance projects. University Housing has been working with the Office of Project Delivery to make improvements to the properties, including laying new asphalt at Wa'ahila and painting the exteriors of K. Nui and K. Iki. Over the next several years, we plan on continuing these improvements, and will provide you with specifics when definite start dates are determined.

A notice with further procedural details regarding the increase and directions on security deposits will be sent out by our property management company, Locations, closer to the implementation date.
