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# PROJECTED TRENDS IN ENROLLMENT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I FALL 2020 TO FALL 2025

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## INTRODUCTION

This report provides a summary of the enrollment projections for the campuses of the University of Hawai'i System: the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa; the University of Hawai'i at Hilo; the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu; the University of Hawai'i Community Colleges: Hawai'i; Honolulu; Kapi'olani; Kaua'i; Leeward; Maui College; Windward. Details on the enrollment projections by campus may be found in the separate reports by UH unit (UH Mānoa, UH Hilo, UH-West O'ahu and the UH Community Colleges).

***The projections are statistical extrapolations of current trends in enrollment by unit. In general, they neither set enrollment targets nor take into consideration planned or potential changes in University policies or procedures. They should be considered as an extension into the future of current enrollment trends and may be used as a foundation for further work in the planning and budgeting processes.***

The enrollment projections are based upon unduplicated headcounts of students enrolled in credit courses. Included are classified students in programs leading to a degree as well as unclassified students. Special students (early admission) have been included for all years, both historical and projected. Historical data are included in the tables and charts to facilitate comparison and analysis. They were extracted from the student enrollment, academic crossover and course registration files. Forecast of Hawai'i public high school seniors has been provided by the State of Hawai'i Department of Education. Forecast of Hawai'i public and private high school graduates has been obtained from the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE).

## PROJECTION METHODOLOGY

The projection method divides the headcount enrollment by classified / unclassified and by undergraduate / graduate. Enrollment of classified undergraduates is further sub-divided by student type: first-time; transfer; returning; continuing. Classified graduate enrollment is sub-divided by degree type: master's; research doctorate; professional practice doctorate; post-baccalaureate; graduate certificate. Unclassified enrollment is sub-divided by type: regular undergraduate; graduate; special (early admission); home-based at other UH campuses. Each group is forecast separately and the results summed to derive the campus or unit total. The projection methods used vary by student type, and may include rates, ratios, trends and constants. The specific methods used and assumptions made in forecasting enrollment may be found in the separate enrollment trend reports by UH unit.

The projection reports by unit have charts (Figure 5 in this report) which illustrate the upper and lower forecast boundaries. These boundaries are based upon the observed average variance in the forecast, as measured over the most recent five or ten-year period. Note that the forecast variance increases with time. For the UH system as a whole, the 1-year forecast variance has averaged 1.8%, while the 6-year forecast variance has averaged 16.4%. The projected numbers given here may be considered mid-level forecasts.

Table 1 presents historical and projected enrollment for each campus and for the UH system in aggregate from fall 2014 to fall 2025. Historical and projected enrollment by student type is presented in Table 2. The annual percentage change in enrollment by campus is shown in Table 3. Table 4 provides enrollment indexes, useful for comparing across campuses, calculated using fall 2019 as the base year. (An enrollment index is illustrated for the UH system in Figure 2 and for each unit in Figures 11 to 14.) Tables 5 and 6 show projected student semester hours (SSH) offered and full-time equivalent (FTE) course enrollment served, respectively. Projected enrollment by attendance status (full-time / part-time) is given in Table 7. Appendix A shows historical and projected enrollment of Hawai'i public high school seniors by geographic district. Appendix B presents the WICHE forecast of Hawai'i public and private high school graduates through 2031-32.

## ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

- Headcount enrollment for the University of Hawai'i declined 2.1% in fall 2019 to measure 49,977 (Tables 1 and Figure 1). This decline marked the eighth consecutive decrease in fall semester enrollment, which has declined by 10,353 students (-17.2%) from the peak enrollment of 60,330 measured in fall 2011.
- In fall 2019, enrollment increased only at Windward CC (+2.4%); enrollment at all the other UH campuses declined: UH Mānoa (-1.2%), UH Hilo (-1.0%); UH West O'ahu (-2.5%); Hawai'i CC (-0.6%); Honolulu CC (-0.9%); Kapi'olani CC (-6.0%); Kauai CC (-7.6%); Leeward CC (-2.1%); UH Maui College (-3.2%). Overall, the UHCC system enrollment declined 2.8% over fall 2018 (Table 3).
- **The enrollment forecast for the UH system projects a 0.4% enrollment decrease in fall 2020, to 49,757 students, slightly lower in fall 2021 followed by mild enrollment growth beginning in fall 2022.** The high projection series shows enrollment rebounding to just under 55,000 by 2025, while the low projection series has enrollment falling to 45,620 by 2025 (Figure 5).
- The Hawai'i Department of Education forecast of public high school seniors shows moderate (9.4%) growth through 2024-25 (Appendix A). The Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) forecast for private high school graduates in

Hawai'i calls for the number of graduates to maintain or exceed 3,000 per year through academic year 2024-25 (Appendix B).

- The going rate (college participation rate) of Hawai'i public high school graduates into the UH system has declined from 40.6% in fall 2011 to 32.3% in fall 2019 (Figure 9). The going rate of private high school graduates into the UH system declined from 33.5% in fall 2010 to 21.8% in fall 2017, but increased to 23.8% in fall 2019. The long-term trend has been for an increasing percentage of Hawai'i high school graduates to enroll in colleges out-of-state and for a declining percentage to attend college in Hawai'i, including the UH campuses. - Classified undergraduate enrollment for the UH system peaked in fall 2012 at 45,544 students (Figure 6). Since then declines have occurred in all classified student types: first-time (-19.4%); transfer (-23.3%) returning (-14.5%) and continuing (-23.4%). Unclassified students have increased since fall 2012 due to growth in the enrollment of early admission students, which have increased from 566 in fall 2012 to 3,252 in fall 2019 (+475%). However, other unclassified types have declined: undergraduate (-21.0%); graduate (-21.4%) and students home-based at other UH campuses (-26.5%).
- After increasing slightly in fall 2018, headcount enrollment at UH Mānoa decreased 1.2% in fall 2019 to measure 17,490, the lowest level since fall 2000. Although classified undergraduate enrollment declined, classified graduate enrollment increased for the second consecutive fall semester. Unclassified enrollment also increased slightly, primarily because of early admission enrollment, which increased from 41 to 78. The forecast calls for enrollment to hold steady in fall 2020 and then increase mildly through fall 2025.
- Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo declined 1.0% in fall 2019 to measure 3,372, the lowest enrollment level since fall 2004. Enrollment has declined 18.9% since the peaked enrollment of 4,157 measured in fall 2012, but results varied by student type. First-time freshmen and classified undergraduate transfer enrollment increased, while continuing and returning enrollment declined. Classified graduate enrollment also declined, but unclassified enrollment increased. Early admission enrollment increased from 92 last fall to 135 in fall 2019 (+46.7%). Headcount enrollment has been forecast to decline slightly in fall 2020 and then increase mildly through fall 2025.
- Since the admission of lower division students began in fall 2007, enrollment growth at UH West O'ahu has been very strong. However, the double digit growth rate realized from fall 2008 to fall 2014 slowed to just 1.5% in fall 2018. The 2.5% decline in

enrollment measured in fall 2019 was the first decrease in enrollment since fall 2003. Classified enrollment declined 3.9%, with declines measured in all student types. Unclassified enrollment increased due to gains in early admissions, which have increased from 67 in fall 2015 to 300 in fall 2019. Enrollment is expected to decrease slightly in fall 2020 and 2021, then stabilize at or near the current level.

- Headcount enrollment for the UH Community Colleges system declined 2.8% in fall 2019 to measure 26,066. Enrollment is now at about the same level as in fall 2007, just before the Great Recession. Classified first-time and transfer enrollment increased somewhat in fall 2019, while returning and continuing enrollment declined. Unclassified enrollment decreased overall, with early admissions enrollment declining for the first time since fall 2012. The forecast has headcount enrollment declining at a decreasing rate through fall 2021 and then beginning to increase slowly through fall 2025.
- All of the UH campuses have developed enrollment management plans and have embarked on strategies to attract new students, including offering college instruction options for high school students, improving transfer pathways, implementing targeted recruitment to area high schools and developing new programs to address the needs of working adults and underserved populations. In general, the enrollment forecasts presented here do not take these strategies into consideration. The numbers shown are based upon observed trends and are intended to provide a baseline for further work in planning and budgeting.

## **SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION**

Headcount enrollment declined 2.1% for the University of Hawai'i system in Fall 2019, down at all but one of the UH campuses. However, there are signs that enrollment is leveling off and may begin to grow again. After many years of decline, classified graduate enrollment at UH Mānoa increased for the second consecutive fall semester. First-time freshmen and classified transfer enrollment increased at UH Hilo, while early admissions enrollment reached a new high at UH West O'ahu. The continued decline in enrollment at the UH Community Colleges reflects economic conditions favorable to employment. When placed into a long-term historical context, the overall headcount enrollment level is still very high (Figure 3). The exceptionally strong enrollment growth realized from fall 2008 to fall 2011 was very likely linked to the unusually severe recession during that period. The current enrollment trend-based forecast has enrollment leveling off at around 49,700 in fall 2021 and then beginning to increase again at a mild rate through fall 2025.

Recent and Projected Headcount Enrollment

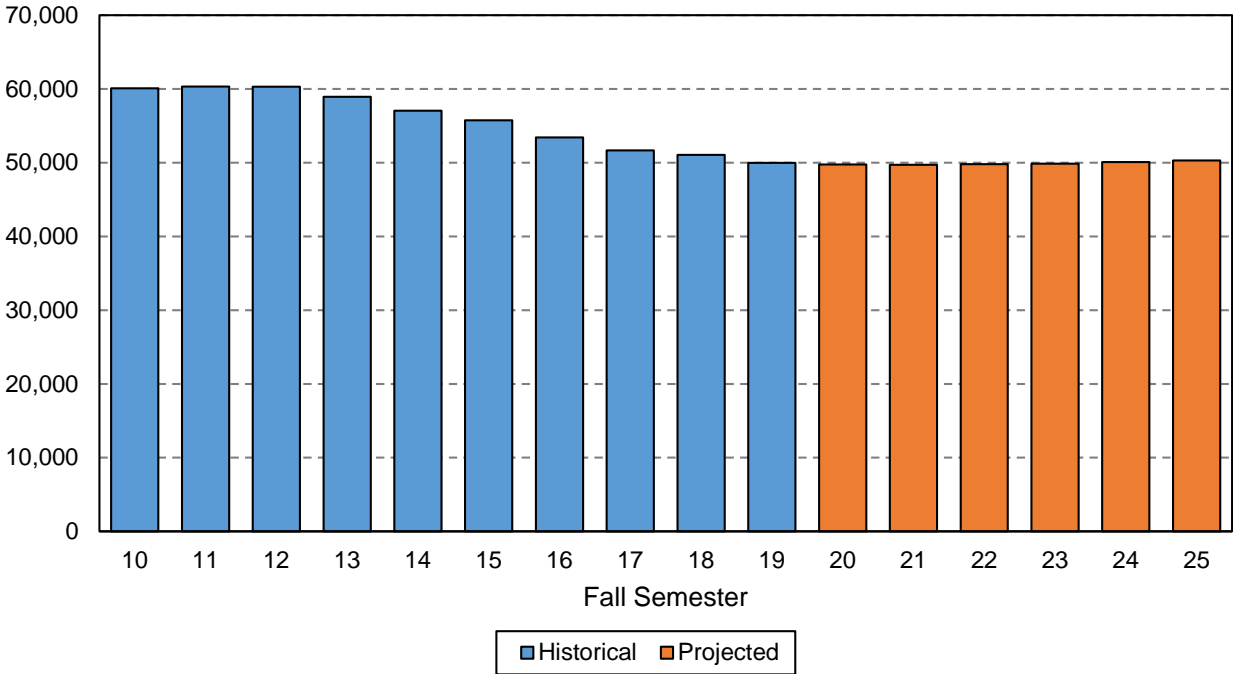
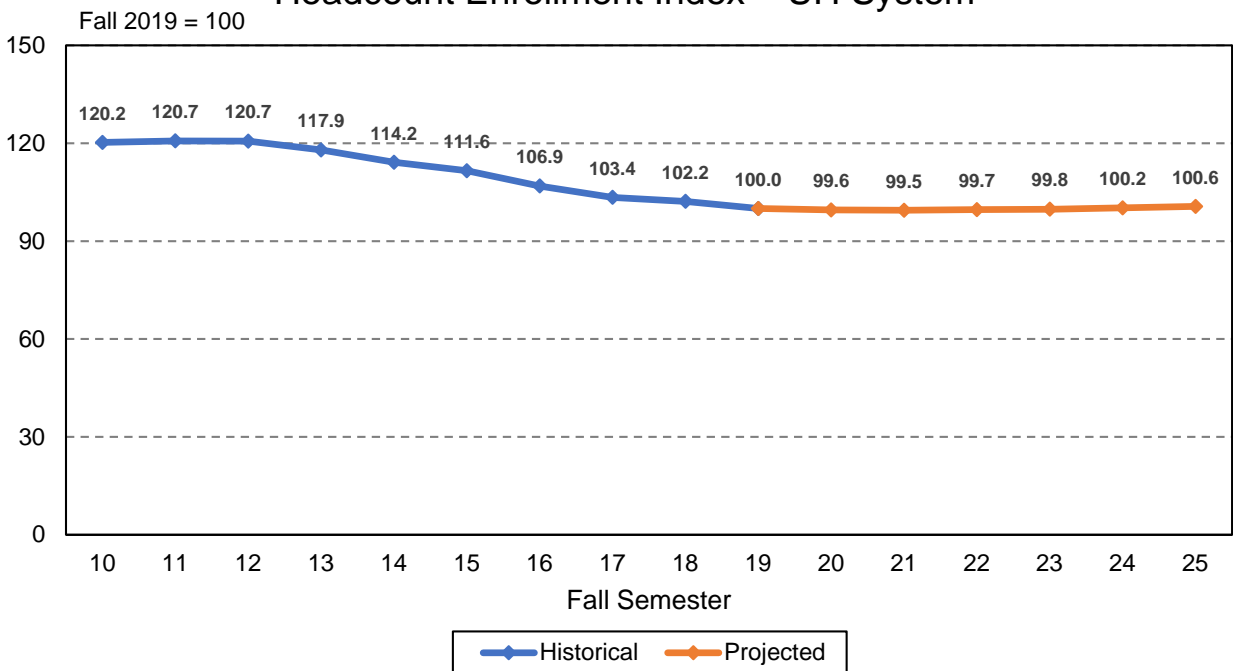


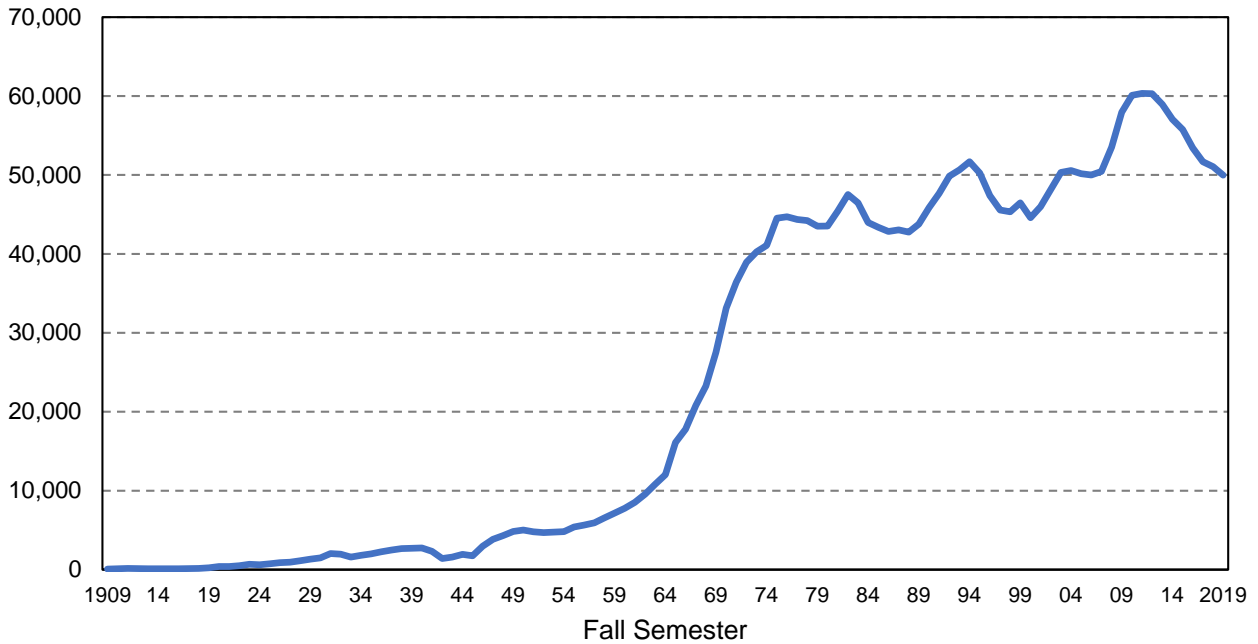

Headcount Enrollment Index – UH System



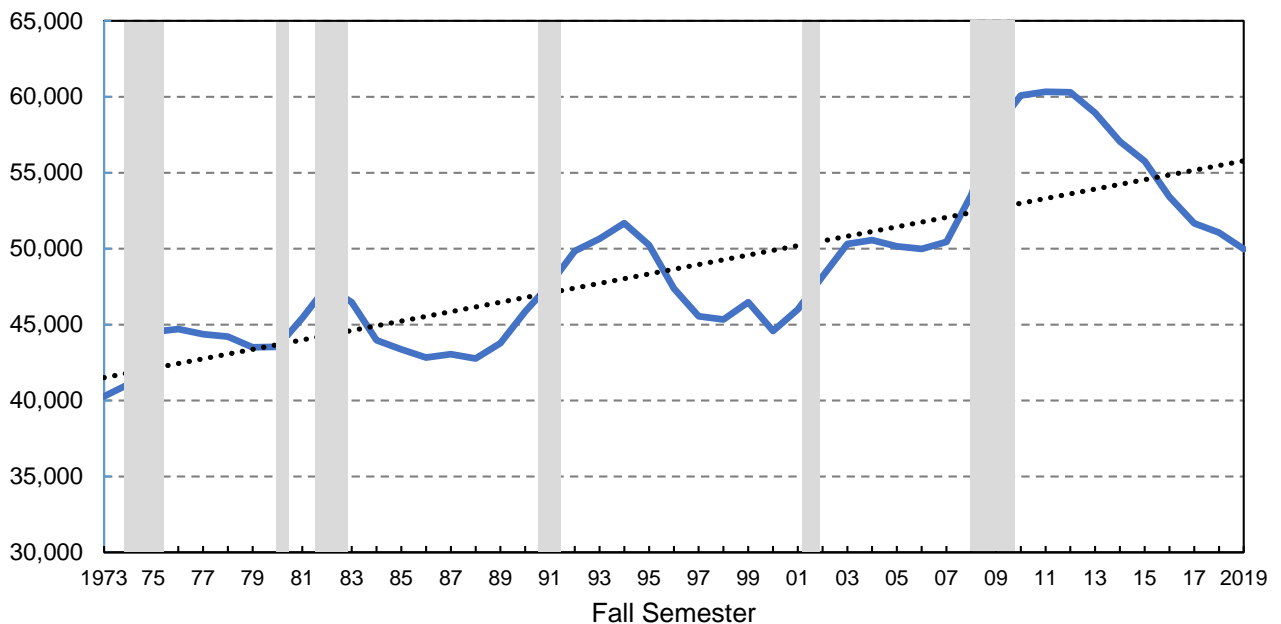

Projected Enrollment with High and Low Series

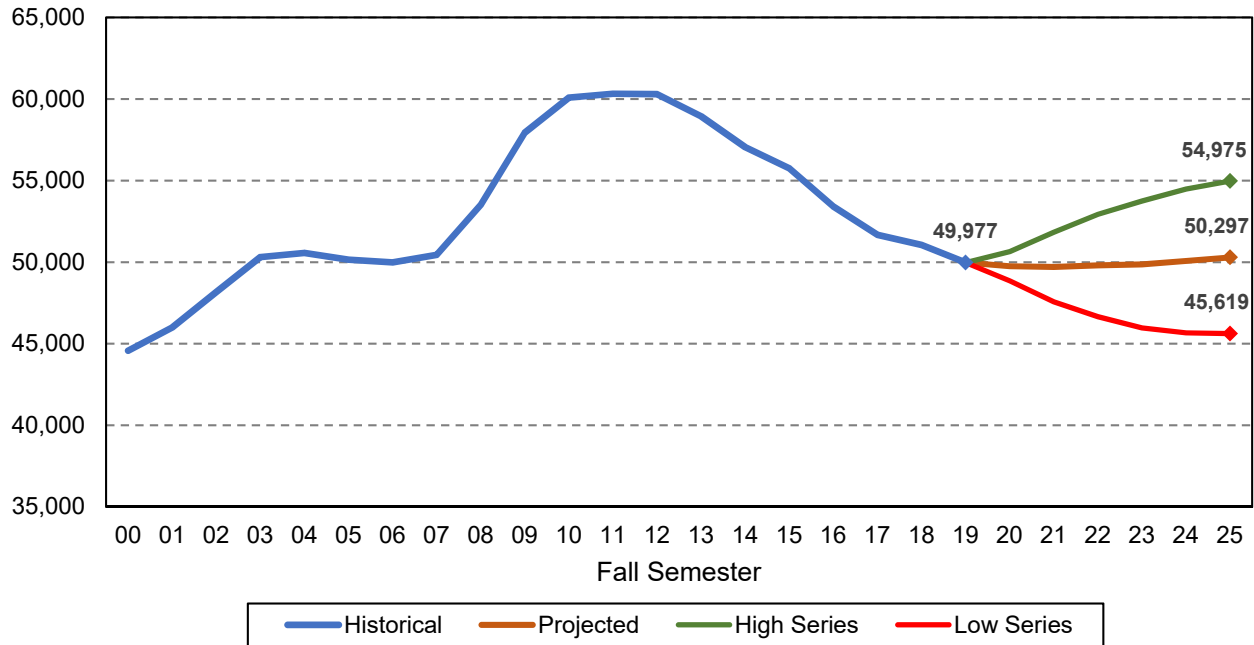
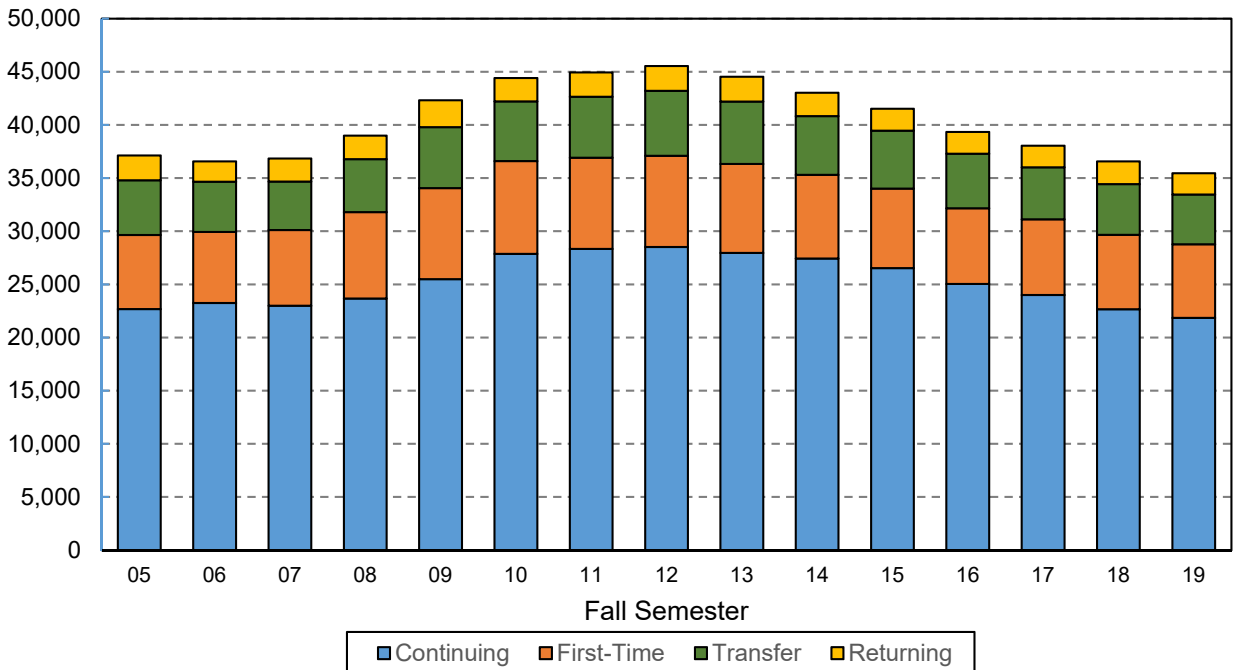

Classified Graduate Enrollment by Degree Type

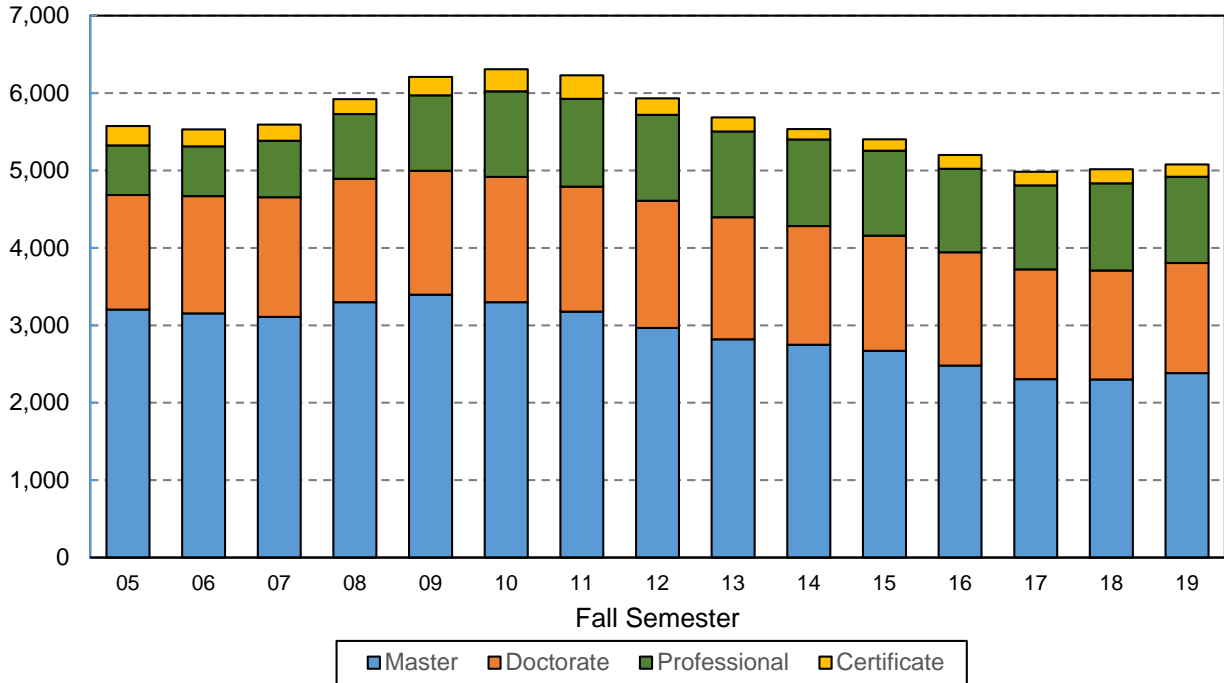
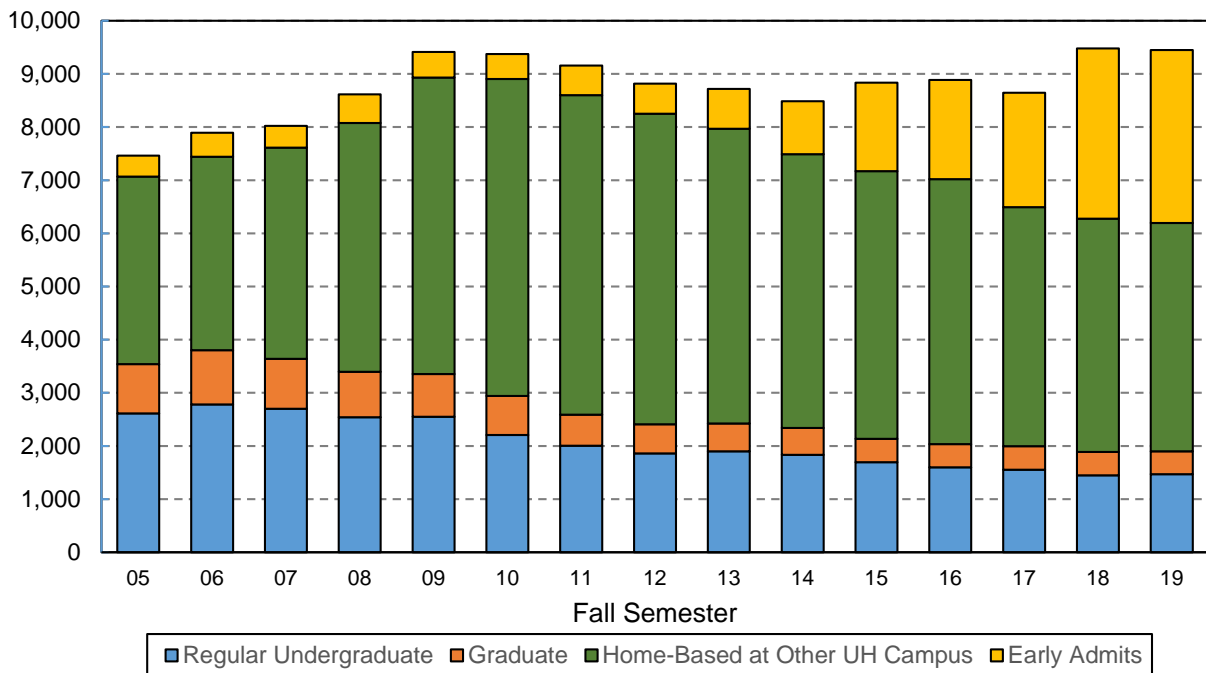
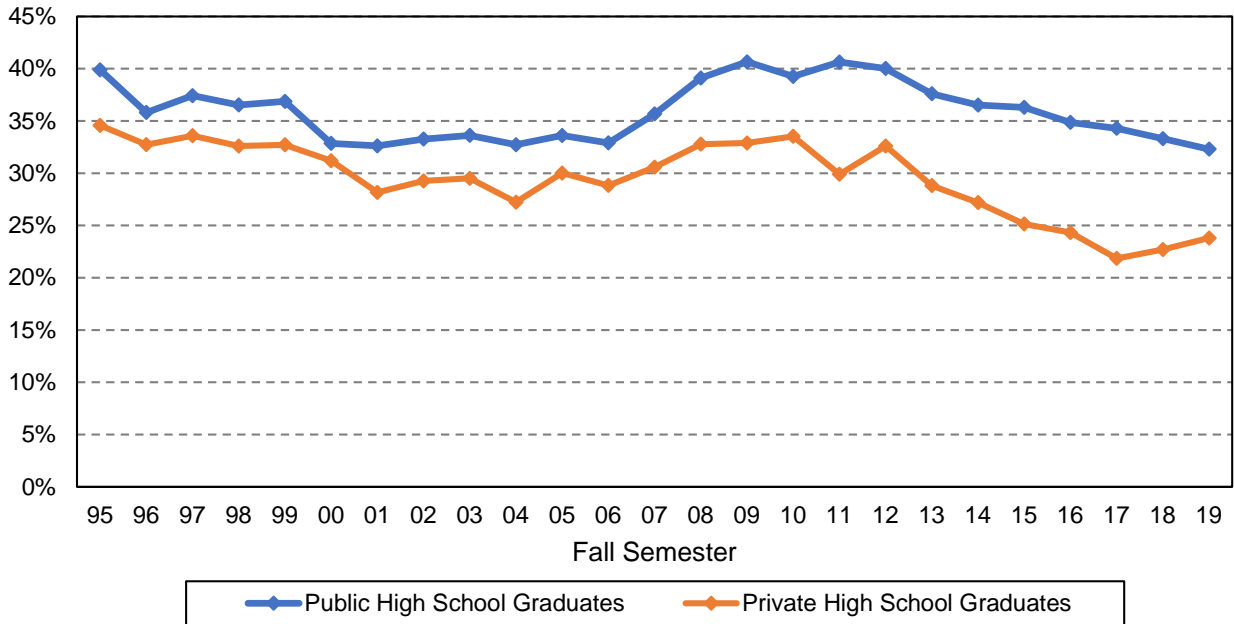

Unclassified Enrollment by Type

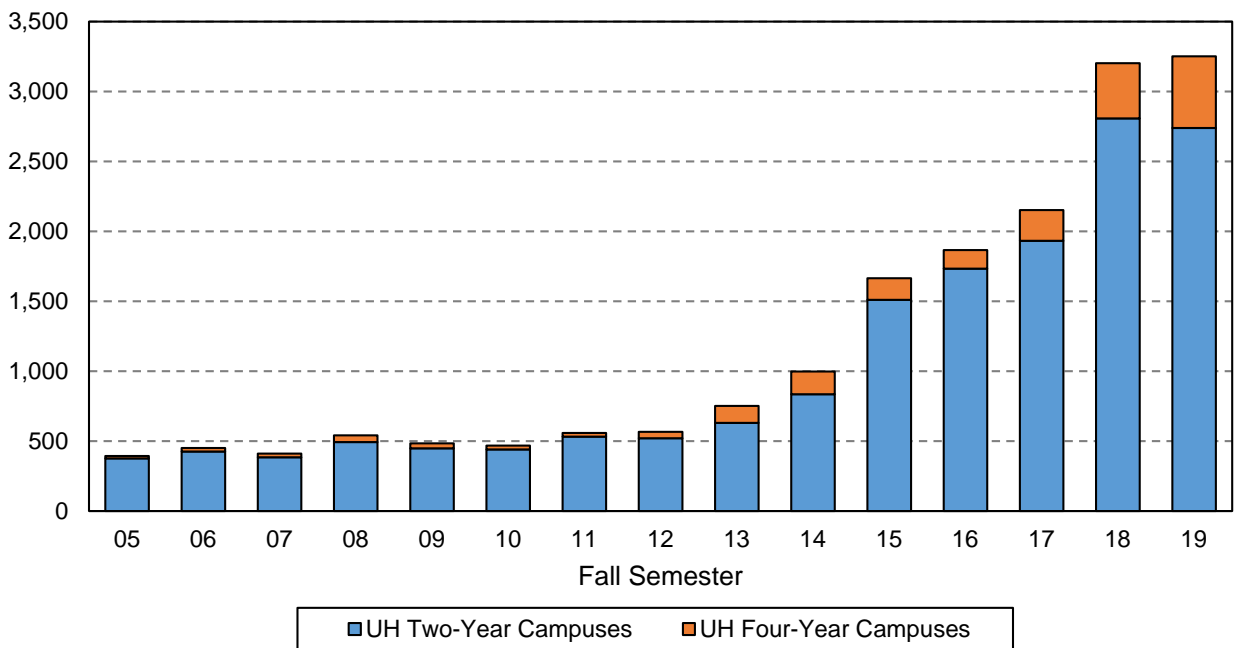

Headcount Enrollment Index – UH Mānoa

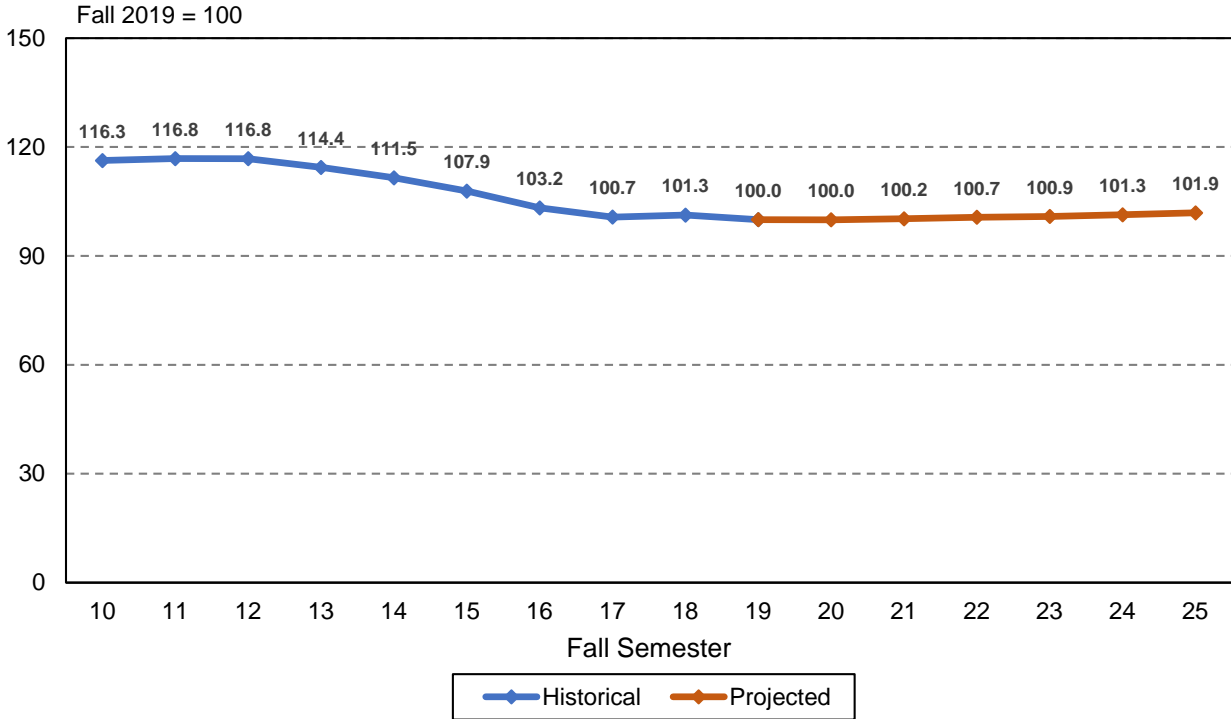
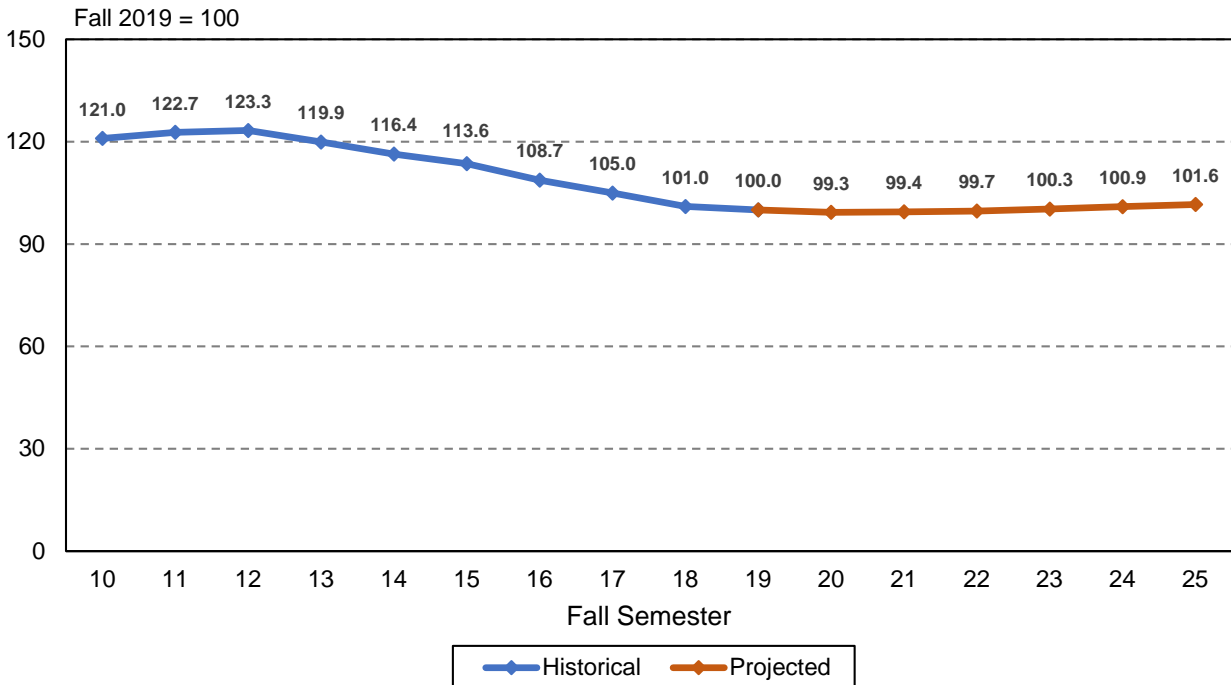
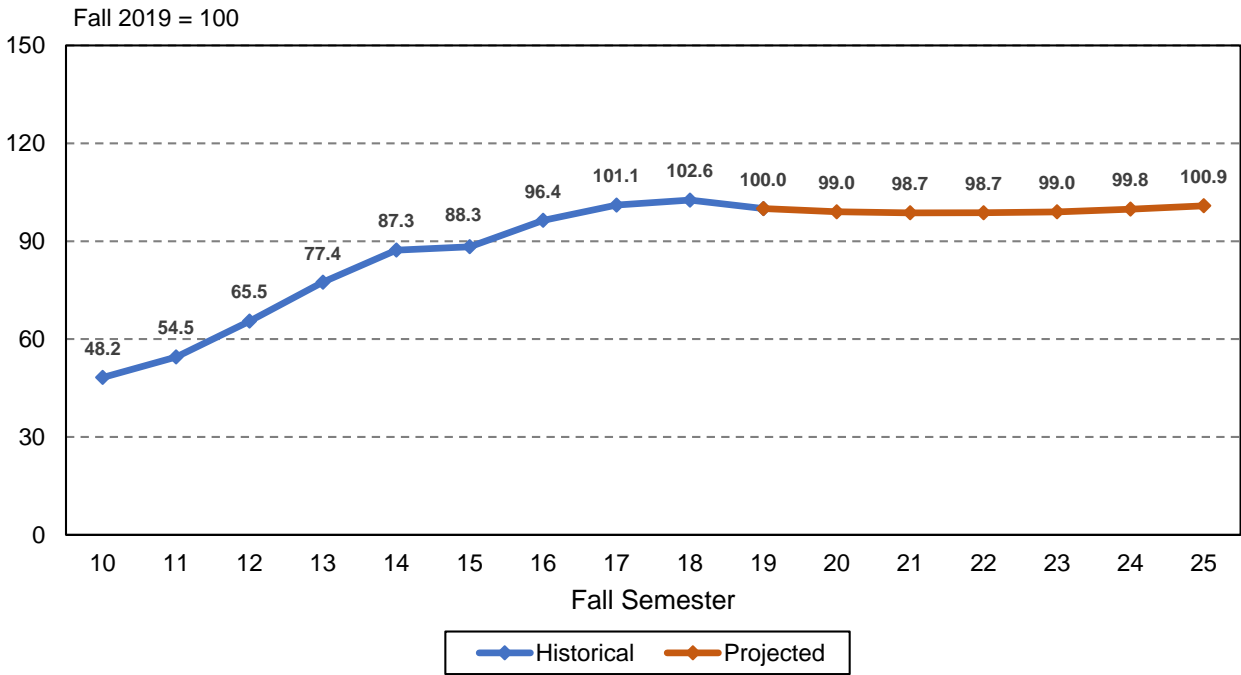

Headcount Enrollment Index – UH Hilo

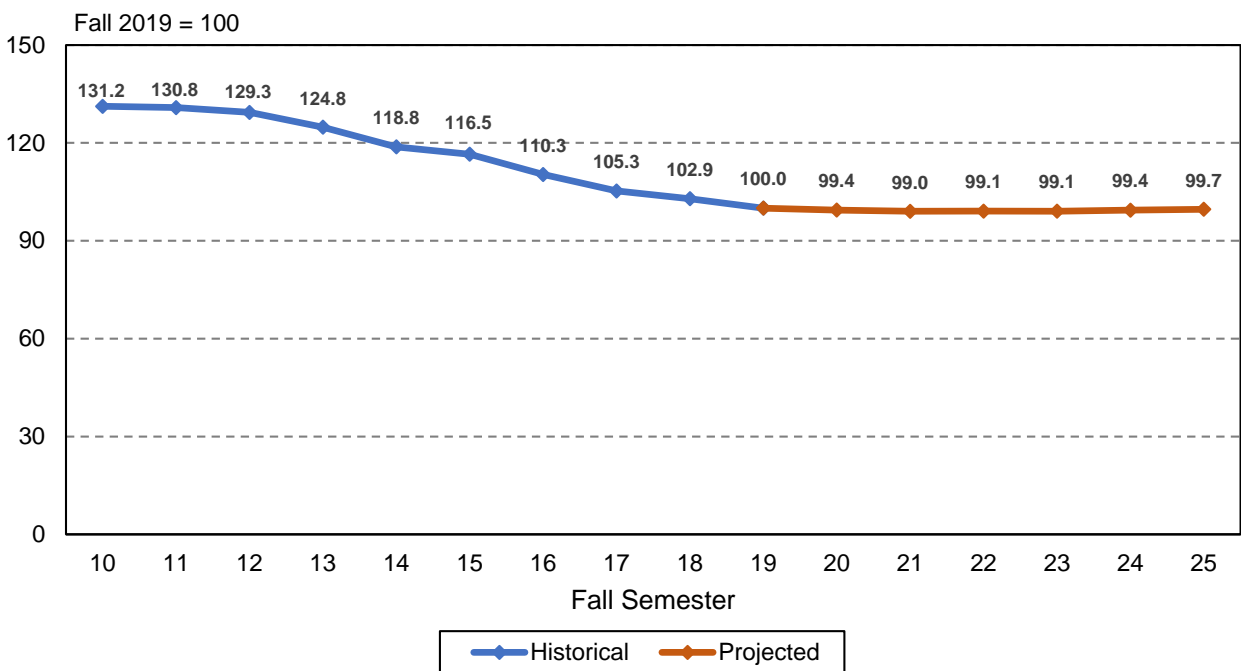
