





#### Contracts and Grants Awards As of Quarter Two – FY 2019




#### Contracts and Grants Expenditures As of Quarter Two – FY 2019








#### Invention Disclosures As of Quarter Two – FY 2019




#### U.S. Provisional Patents Filed As of Quarter Two – FY 2019






UH Hilo Geology Department / CSAV working with the USGS Hawaiian Volcano Observatory provided the first-ever "realtime" analysis of chemical changes in the lava that allowed prediction of change in eruptive volumes 5 days prior to occurrence. USGS Cooperative Grant \$300,000.

UH Hilo Geography Department provided 24 hour a day, 7 day a week, drone surveillance to Hawai'l County Civil Defense with night time thermal cameras. Streaming video allowed for real-time decision making by authorities. NSF RAPID GRANT AWARD for \$55,000.






