




Table 3. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 4. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2009




Table 5. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009






Table 12. UH Community Colleges Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. UH Community Colleges Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009





Table 15. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 18. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009





Table 19. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 2. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2009




Table 3. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 5. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009




Table 10. Hawaii Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2009




Table 11. Last Term Attended Fall 2006 to Fall 2009




Table 12. Hawaii Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Hawai'i Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Hawaii Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009





Table 15. Hawaii Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 18. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009







Table 2. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2009




Table 3. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 4. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2009




Table 5. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009






Table 12. Honolulu Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Honolulu Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 15. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 16. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009




Table 17. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2009




Table 18. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009







Table 2. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2009




Table 3. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 4. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2009




Table 5. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Kapiʻolani Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009




Table 10. Kapi'olani Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2009




Table 11. Last Term Attended Fall 2006 to Fall 2009




Table 12. Kapiolani Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Kapi'olani Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 15. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 16. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009




Table 17. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2009




Table 18. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009







Table 2. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2009




Table 3. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 4. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2009




Table 5. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009




Table 10. Kaua'i Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2009




Table 11. Last Term Attended Fall 2006 to Fall 2009




Table 12. Kauai Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Kaua'i Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 15. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 16. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009




Table 17. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2009




Table 18. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009






Table 3. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 4. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2009




Table 5. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009




Table 8. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009




Table 10. Leeward Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2009




Table 11. Leeward Community College Last Attended Fall 2006 - Fall 2009




Table 12. Leeward Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Leeward Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009





Table 14. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 16. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009




Table 17. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2009




Table 18. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2009








Table 5. Maui Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009







Table 8. Maui Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2009




Table 9. Maui Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2009




Table 10. Maui Community CollegeDegrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2009




Table 11. Last Term Attended Fall 2006 to Fall 2009




Table 12. Maui Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Maui Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 15. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 16. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009








Table 3. Windward Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2009




Table 5. Windward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2009




Table 6. Windward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2009




Table 7. Windward Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2009






Table 12. Windward Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2006 to Spring 2009)




Table 13. Windward Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2009




Table 14. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2009




Table 15. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2009




Table 16. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2009




Table 17. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2009





