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HB 3237, HD1: Relating to Early Childhood Education

Chair Takamine, Vice Chair Kawakami, and Members of the Committee:

The University of Hawai'i supports HB 3237, HD1 which establishes an inter-departmental working group to plan a state early learning system that will be accessible to all four-year-olds in the state. The rationale for quality early care and education is articulated well in the bill, and the University is fully supportive of efforts to improve early learning and care for Hawai'i's young children. The proposed working group is needed to ensure that new services provided are appropriate and efficiently operated. The investment in planning should pay large dividends in the long term. With that in mind, we urge that the suggested level of funding not be reduced.
