HB 1530, HD 1 – RELATING TO EDUCATION

One of the purposes of HB 1530, HD 1 is to create an educational assistant loan program and special fund at the University of Hawai'i and to establish a loan forgiveness program to recruit and retain qualified teachers and educational assistant to work in rural areas throughout the State of Hawai'i.
