HB1405 HD2 SD1 – RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX

Chair Kim, Vice Chair Tsutsui, and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on this measure.

The University of Hawai'i is in support of Section 19 of the bill, which provides that

(4) <u>A sum equal to</u> per cent of all tax revenues realized by the State under chapters A, <u>B</u>, and C, respectively, shall be deposited in the state treasury in each fiscal year to the credit of the University of Hawaii; provided that any moneys received under this section shall augment and not replace existing operating or capital improvement budgets; provided further that beginning January 1, ___, all revenues realized by the State under chapters A, B, and C shall be deposited in the state treasury.""

This provision will provide an additional source of funding for high-priority higher education programs.
