## SB 1173, Relating to Perinatal Care

I wish to express my support for SB 1173, provided that its passage does not replace or adversely impact priorities of the University as expressed in our Board of Regents-approved Executive Biennium Budget.

SB 1173 proposes to appropriate funds for the Department of Human Services to contract with the university clinical educational and research associates (UCERA) program at the University of Hawai'i department of obstetrics, gynecology, and women's health to continue the pilot perinatal clinic and the provision of case management services.
