SB 1351 – RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT HILO

Chairs Tokuda and Fukunaga, Vice Chairs Sakamoto and Baker, and members of the Senate Committee on Higher Education: Thank you very much for this opportunity to testify on Senate Bill 1351 that establishes in statute the Vice Chancellor for Research and Development at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo.

We thank the legislature for this intent to support the growth of the University of Hawai'i at Hilo. The University of Hawai'i supports this proposal in principle at some future date after appropriate review, recognizing that UH Hilo's growing research activity will require more coordination and leadership.

Creating additional executive personnel at UH requires appropriate review by the Board of Regents within the context of a review of UH Hilo's mission and its role within the UH system. We would also note that an amendment to statute is not required to establish this office or position.
