SB 2837 RELATING TO LICENSING

Chair Baker, Vice Chair Ige, and Members of the Committee:

The community colleges are prepared to provide the education and training necessary to meet the licensing requirements contained in this bill. I would like to request, however, that the language in the bill be changed by replacing Honolulu Community College with a University of Hawai'i community college offering an appropriate program of study.
