FEMALE RESPONSES

Partner Violence

78 female respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at UH Mānoa.

Of these females:

16 reported it happening on campus	13 said it happened one time
19 told no one	20 said it happened 2 - 4 times
8 reported it to police	19 said it happened 5 or more times
1 reported it to campus security	24 were not sure how many times
4 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty	

Survey Definition: Partner violence is when your boy/girlfriend, husband/wife, date, lover and/or special friend are abusive to you. This can include verbal abuse (like name calling or put downs), physical abuse (like hitting, slapping or pushing) and/or emotional/mental abuse (like threatening you or your family, controls who you see/talk to, controls the money, and/or drives carelessly with you in the car).

Stalking

84 female respondents reported being stalked since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these females:

35 reported it happening on campus	16 said it happened one time
4 told no one	30 said it happened 2 - 4 times
4 reported it to police	9 said it happened 5 or more times
1 reported it to campus security	24 were not sure how many times
2 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty	

Survey Definition: Stalking is when someone you know or do not know repeatedly follows you, watches you, calls, writes, e-mails or communicates with you in ways that are unwanted, seem obsessive and/or makes you feel afraid or concerned for your safety.

Rape

15 female respondents reported being raped since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these females:

4 reported it happening on campus	8 said it happened one time
2 told no one	2 said it happened 2 - 4 times
0 reported it to police	0 said it happened 5 or more times
0 reported it to campus security	4 were not sure how many times
0 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty	

Survey Definition: Rape is when someone forces you to have oral, anal or vaginal sex. It includes putting a penis in your mouth, vagina or anus and/or putting a finger or object (like a bottle) in your vagina or anus - against your will. It also includes someone putting their mouth on your vagina, penis or anus and/or someone forcing you to put your mouth on their penis, vagina or anus - against your will.

Sexual Assault

39 female respondents reported being sexually assaulted since starting school at UH Mānoa.

Of these females:

18 reported it happening on campus	13 said it happened one time
3 told no one	13 said it happened 2 - 4 times
5 reported it to police	6 said it happened 5 or more times
1 reported it to campus security	5 were not sure how many times
1 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty	

Survey Definition: Sexual assault is unwanted touching of a sexual nature like forced kissing, touching of private parts, grabbing, fondling and/or rubbing up against you in a sexual way, even if it is over your clothes.

MALE RESPONSES

Partner Violence

55 Male respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at UH Mānoa.

Of these Males:

14 reported it happening on campus	6 said it happened one time
28 told no one	7 said it happened 2 - 4 times
3 reported it to police	9 said it happened 5 or more times
0 reported it to campus security	29 were not sure how many times
5 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty

1 reported it to police	6 said it happened 5 or more times
2 reported it to campus security	10 were not sure how many times
1 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty

Rape

5 Male respondents reported being raped since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these Males:

3 reported it happening on campus	1 said it happened one time
2 told no one	1 said it happened 2 - 4 times
0 reported it to police	1 said it happened 5 or more times
0 reported it to campus security	2 were not sure how many times
1 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty
