# Commission on the Status of Women Summary of Data from the Student Survey on Sexual and Relationship Violence UH Mānoa

20 lecture classes surveyed 1096 responses usable for analysis 565 female responses 531 male responses 1 FTM response

### FEMALE RESPONSES

### Partner Violence

78 female respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these females:

16 reported it happening on campus13 said it happened one time19 told no one20 said it happened 2 - 4 times8 reported it to police19 said it happened 5 or more times1 reported it to campus security24 were not sure how many times

4 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty

Survey Definition: Partner violence is when your boy/girlfriend, husband/wife, date, lover and/or special friend are abusive to you. This can include verbal abuse (like name calling or put downs), physical abuse (like hitting, slapping or pushing) and/or emotional/mental abuse (like threatening you or your family, controls who you see/talk to, controls the money, and/or drives carelessly with you in the car).

### Stalking

84 female respondents reported being stalked since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these females:

35 reported it happening on campus16 said it happened one time4 told no one30 said it happened 2 - 4 times4 reported it to police9 said it happened 5 or more times1 reported it to campus security24 were not sure how many times

2 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty

## Rape

15 female respondents reported being raped since starting school at UH Mānoa. Of these females:

4 reported it happening on campus
2 told no one
2 reported it to police
3 reported it to police
4 reported it to police
5 or more times
6 reported it to campus security
4 were not sure how many times

0 reported it to UH Mānoa staff/faculty
