

## Common Visa Types Seen in Hawaii

Visa Type	Description
A	Diplomats, their family, dependents, and workers. Other accredited officials (A-2), or employees of foreign governments.
B	(B-1) Visitor for Business. (B-2) Visitor for Pleasure/Tourist
E	Treaty Traders and Investors who come to establish a business or trade in the USA. (E-2) Dependents of Treaty Traders or Investors
F	Students admitted to attend school full time in the USA. (F-2) Dependents of Students
G	Designated principal represents of foreign governments coming to the USA to work for an Intl Orgn
H	(H-1B) Temporary workers in specialty occupations invited to work at specific place of business due to professional or technical skills. (H-4) Spouses & dependents of H visa holders
J	Exchange visitors coming into the USA to study, work, or train as part of an exchange program recognized by the US Dept of State. (J-2) Dependents of J visa holders
M	Vocational or nonacademic students. (M-2) Dependents of M visa holders.
O	Persons of extraordinary ability of the sciences, arts, education, business, or athletics
P	Internationally recognized athletes and entertainers, and their essential support staff
Q	Exchange visitors coming into the USA to participate in Intl cultural exchange programs
TN	Trade visa for Canadians & Mexicans
