HONOLULU – Today the Regents Candidate Advisory Council (RCAC) delivered to Governor Linda Lingle's office a list of candidates for the University of Hawai'i Board of Regents (BOR). A list of 22 candidates was provided, from which 12 may be nominated by the governor for appointment to the BOR for seats to be filled effective July 1, 2008, with the consent of the Senate. The total number of BOR members is 15. Members whose terms are continuing include BOR Chair Allan R. Landon and members James J. C. Haynes II and Ronald K. Migita. The RCAC was established to identify qualified candidates from which members of the BOR are to be nominated. There are 7 members of the RCAC representing various constituent groups. The RCAC held public forums on O'ahu, Kaua'i, Maui and the Big Island in August 2007 to inform the public about the RCAC's proposed rules, procedures, and selection criteria for BOR candidates. Upon finalization of the rules, criteria, and procedures an awareness campaign about the nomination and application process was conducted. The RCAC solicited nominations and began reviewing applications on November 1, 2007.

Upon completion of applicant interviews, RCAC finalized the list of candidates presented to the governor today. From this list, the governor will select nominees for the BOR. With the consent of the Senate, the nominees may be appointed to the BOR by the governor. More information about the candidates is available by calling the RCAC at 692-1218.
