**RCAC Releases Names of Finalists for  
Three Seats on the UH Board of Regents**

The Regents Candidate Advisory Council (RCAC) began the recruitment process during Fall 2009 to attract qualified candidates for a Honolulu County seat, a Maui County seat, and a Student seat on the University of Hawaii Board of Regents.

The outgoing regents whose terms will end on June 30, 2010 include James Haynes (Maui County), Chuck Gee (Honolulu County), and Grant Teichman (Student).

Upon completion of applicant interviews, background and reference checks, RCAC finalized the list of candidates which was presented to the Governor today. Governor Lingle must select nominees for the Board of Regents from this list, and her appointments must be confirmed by the State Senate during the current legislative session.
