Keynote Speaker: Karen Miotto, M.D.
Clinical Professor
Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences
UCLA School of Medicine

Dr. Karen Miotto is a Clinical Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at UCLA and the Director of the UCLA Addiction Medicine Service. Dr. Miotto is the Chair to the Clinical Advisory Task Force on Physician Health for the California Society of Addiction Medicine. She has also chaired the UCLA Medical Staff Health Committee for the past 10 years. Dr. Miotto is frequently an invited

speaker at local and international addiction meetings. She is the recipient of a career development award from the National Institute on Drug Abuse and is an investigator in the area of addiction pharmacology.

Dr. William Haning is a Professor of Psychiatry at the John A. Burns School of Medicine, University of Hawai'i, serving as the Director, Psychiatry Residency Training Program and Associate Chair for Education for the Department of Psychiatry. He is the Principal Investigator for the Pacific Addiction Research Center (PARC®).
