

Professor Hanae Kramer's presentation is the story of the *Nikudan-san'yūshi* phenomenon: told as a brief history of one of Japan's greatest media sensations as well as an explanation of a cultural movement that glorified self-sacrifice and which promoted suicide attacks as a legitimate military tactic. She will also explain her exhibit "Japanese Suicide Bombers, 1932." The exhibit is from November 6, 2017 through January 12, 2018, on the 4th floor of the Hamilton Library.
