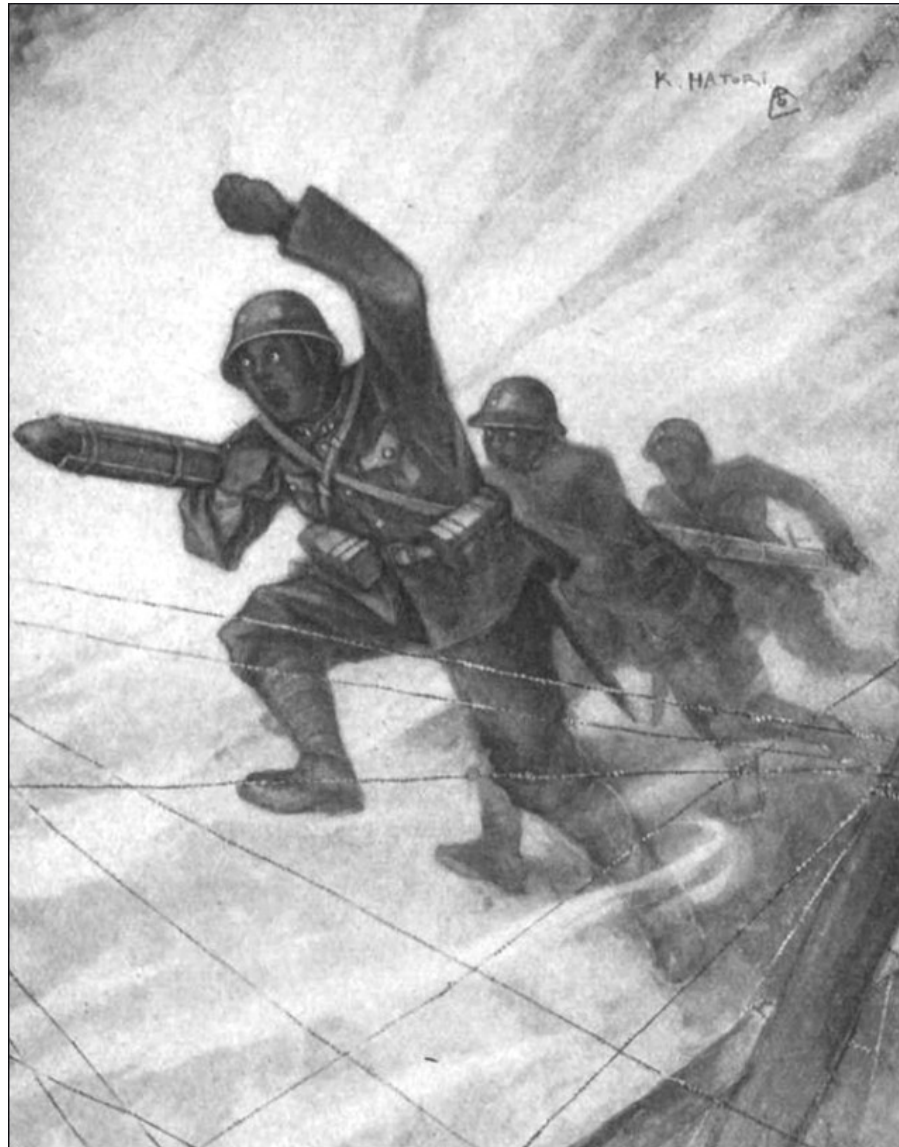

Professor Hanae Kramer's presentation is the story of the *Nikudan-san'yūshi* phenomenon: told as a brief history of one of Japan's greatest media sensations as well as an explanation of a cultural movement that glorified self-sacrifice and which promoted suicide attacks as a legitimate military tactic. She will also explain her exhibit "Japanese Suicide Bombers, 1932." The exhibit is from November 6, 2017 through January 12, 2018, on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the Hamilton Library.
