A8.528 Acquisition

Purpose

The University may acquire property as a direct charge to a Federal contract or grant only when specified in the contract or grant or when authorized in writing by a contracting officer. Departments shall comply with A8.290, Requirements of Federally Funded Purchases, and with all flowdown provisions imposed by the prime recipient when the University is a subcontractor in receipt of Federal funds. Departments must also be aware of any agency-specific purchasing screening requirements. Some examples are (but not limited to):

1. Department of Defense Awards

- a. When purchasing Industrial Plant Equipment (IPE) with an acquisition price of \$15,000 or more on Department of Defense (DOD)contracts, the agency requires completion and submission of DD Form 1419 (DOD Industrial Plant Equipment Requisition)to the cognizant Administrative Contracting Officer.

2. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) Awards

When purchasing Centrally Reportable Equipment (CRE) as defined in APM A8.290, which is expected to cost \$5,000 or more under NASA contracts or \$1,000 or more on JPL subcontracts, completion and submission of DD Form 1419 is required.
