Subject: Proposed Additional Changes to RP 6.208 Board Exemptions to Non-Resident Tuition

Dear Mr. Fern:

Regents Policy 6.208 was recently revised in February 2022. A few further changes are being proposed as described below.

- 1) RP 6.208 defines when students may be granted waivers of the non-resident tuition differential (NRTD). This policy is being updated to include ROTC students at the University. Although most ROTC participants are residents, it is important to include this program which awards additional scholarship funds to support these students' other costs of attendance. This may also encourage the federal government to allow more students to participate in ROTC.
- 2) Item III.F. is being further clarified with reference to other Board of Regents' policies that may be related to non-residential tuition differentials.
