Salaries or wages, honoraria, entertainment, research scholarships, food, apparel, and travel will not be funded.

Since grants are awarded on an annual basis and no funds are held in reserve, supplementary requests cannot be funded. Funded grants for 2023-2024 will be announced and funds will be released in early 2024. An average grant award is up to \$4,000.
