SUBJECT: New and Revised State Authorization Regulations Effective July 1, 2020

Attached are the documents discussed at the September 17 joint CCAO/CSSAO meeting pertaining to new and revised state authorization regulations that became effective July 1, 2020. The requirements encompass a broad array of areas, including state licensure reciprocity requirements for providing distance education, the determination of a student's location and related institutional policies, disclosures about institutional transfer credit policies, as well as disclosures about academic programs that lead to state licensure or certification (for both in person and distance education students), etc.
