Tranche 1 (Student Grants) is to "...provide emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care."

Tranche 2 (Institutional Portion) may be used to "...cover any costs associated with significant changes to the delivery of instruction due to the coronavirus, so long as such costs do not include payment to contractors for the provision of preenrollment recruitment activities; endowments; or capital outlays associated with facilities related to athletics, sectarian instructions, or religious worship."

Tranche 3 (Minority-Serving Institutions) may be used to "...defray expenses (including lost revenue, reimbursement for expenses already incurred, technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff training, payroll) incurred by institutions of higher education and for grants to students for any component of the student's cost of attendance including food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care."

Campuses have 1 year (365 calendar days) from the date of the award to expend these funds, which would be roughly late-April 2021.

USDOE guidance was initially unclear and changing. This resulted in a slight delay in spending these funds to ensure compliance.

Campuses are on track to spend funds in early 2021 as certainty around other fiscal portions of UH (General Fund, TFSF, etc.) increases. Unspent tranche 2 and tranche 3 money may be used for student grants to ensure that UH fully expends those funds.


