SUBJECT: Cross-Listed and Concurrent Classes for Summer 2022 (Due July 9, 2022)

Please have the data for your cross-listed and concurrent classes for Summer 2022 in Banner by **July 9, 2022**. Please note that classes added after the July 9, 2022 due date can only be processed if time allows. This information is needed for accurate reporting of official course registration data for accreditation purposes, program reviews, and other similar requests.

Cross-listed classes consist of two or more classes with **different subject codes (course alphas)** taught by an instructor who is in one physical location — <a href="https://www.hawaii.edu/ovppp/sdoc/Instructional Method Memo May2021.pdf">https://www.hawaii.edu/ovppp/sdoc/Instructional Method Memo May2021.pdf</a> may be used - at the same time, e.g., PSY 100 and WS 100. A student registers for only one of the courses and the instructor is credited with teaching only one class. In order to avoid double counting of classes, please assign one of the classes as the primary. The primary class should, in most cases, be with the department that provides the instructor for the class.

Please use the following codes for the assignment type field, ASTY, in the Faculty Assignment Form (SIAASGN):

XP - Cross-listed, primary

XS1 - Cross-listed, secondary 1

XS2 - Cross-listed, secondary 2

XS3 - Cross-listed, secondary 3

XS4 - Cross-listed, secondary 4

XS5 - Cross-listed, secondary 5

XSX - Cross-listed, secondary 6+

ZZ - Not cross-listed or concurrent

Only one primary class (XP) can be assigned to a cross-list group and it should be assigned to the primary instructor teaching the class. If there is no primary class assigned to a group, the course registration reports will adjust by assigning a primary class to the lowest numbered course reference number (CRN).

For classes with multiple secondary classes, prioritize them numerically, i.e., XS1, XS2, etc. This information is important in instances when the primary class has no students registered and the next secondary class, starting with XS1, is reassigned as primary, provided it has students registered. If there are only 2 classes in a set, only XP needs to be assigned.

For concurrent sets of classes, where the course alphas are the same, primary and secondary assignments will be systematically assigned in IRAPO's course data table, therefore, manual input is not necessary, but highly recommended.

If a class is not cross-listed or concurrent in the SSAXLST form, assign ZZ. Otherwise, the class will be processed as concurrent or cross-listed. Additional details regarding the documentation of cross-listed and concurrent classes can be found in the <a href="Faculty Assignment for Cross-listed and Concurrent Classes">Faculty Assignment for Cross-listed and Concurrent Classes</a> memo sent to UH Schedulers and the Council of Chief Academic Officers on October 7, 2019.
